Recognizes and honors Deputy William Bowman (1964-2000) for his service to this state.

CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

2	Whereas Deputy William Bowman was born on December 22, 1964, in
3	Annandale, Virginia, to Ronald and Billie Jo Bowman; and
4	Whereas Deputy Bowman graduated from Sunset High School in
5	Beaverton, Oregon, in June 1983; and
6	Whereas Deputy Bowman became a paramedic, joining AA Ambulance
7	and working in the basic life support ambulance, then proceeding to ad-
8	vanced life support in north Portland; and
9	Whereas Deputy Bowman was a quick study whose passion for his work
10	and sense of humor helped the sick and injured through difficult ordeals; and
11	Whereas Deputy Bowman became a flight paramedic for the Life Flight
12	Network in 1988; and
13	Whereas while remaining an active paramedic with American Medical
L 4	Response and the Life Flight Network, Deputy Bowman served as a reserve
15	officer for the Beaverton Police Department from 1992 to 1994; and
16	Whereas in the summer of 1994, Deputy Bowman was appointed to the
L 7	Department of Public Safety Standards and Training Class 187 and was
18	sworn in to the Clackamas County Sheriff's Office; and
19	Whereas Deputy Bowman married Corie Foote in 1995 and was present
20	at the birth of his first child, Lauren Elizabeth, on October 29, 1997, and of
21	his second child, Grace Ellen, on July 3, 2000; and

1	Whereas on September 12, 2000, Deputy Bowman was shot and killed
2	during a Special Weapons and Tactics (SWAT) training exercise at Camp
3	Rilea, Oregon; and
4	Whereas Deputy Bowman and 10 other officers were training in a mock
5	building when a live round was fired from another officer's weapon, striking
6	Deputy Bowman in the head; and
7	Whereas Deputy Bowman had served with the Clackamas County Sheriff's
8	Office for six years and had been part of the SWAT team for two years, as
9	well as being a member of the Clackamas County Sheriff's Honor Guard and
10	a defensive tactics instructor for the SWAT team; and
11	Whereas Deputy Bowman never forgot his roots as a paramedic, and car-
12	ried a trauma pack with him in his police car, saving lives when he was first
13	to arrive on scene; and
L 4	Whereas Deputy Bowman was a man of many talents and interests who
15	enjoyed flying model airplanes, tinkering with cars and, above all, spending
16	time with his family; and
17	Whereas Deputy Bowman is survived by his wife, his two daughters, his
18	mother and his sister; and
19	Whereas Deputy Bowman was loved by many and is greatly missed; now
