2	Whereas Sergeant Donald R. Walters was born on September 16, 1969, in
3	Colorado Springs, Colorado, and raised by Norman and Arlene Walters; and
4	Whereas the Walters family moved to Oregon in 1981, and Sergeant
5	Walters graduated from North Salem High School in 1988; and
6	Whereas following in his father's footsteps, Sergeant Walters enlisted in
7	the United States Army, serving in the Persian Gulf War and guarding Iraqi
8	prisoners; and
9	Whereas Sergeant Walters was in and out of the Army after 1991 as he
10	struggled with his experiences in the Persian Gulf War, but after the Sep-
11	tember 11 attacks in 2001, Sergeant Walters was convinced he needed to
12	serve his country again; and
13	Whereas Sergeant Walters believed in freedom and was prepared to lay
14	down his life for his family and his country; and
15	Whereas Sergeant Walters died on March 23, 2003, after he was captured
16	by Iraqi fighters in an ambush near Nasiriyah, Iraq, and executed; and
17	Whereas Sergeant Walters' family was presented with the Silver Star and
18	Purple Heart for his heroic actions in combat; and
19	Whereas Sergeant Walters was known for his good work ethic, his kind
20	demeanor, his willingness to protect others and his desire to serve, and for
21	being one of the most motivated soldiers; and
