A BILL FOR AN ACT

- 2 Relating to coordinated care organizations; and declaring an emergency.
- 3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
- SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2016 Act is added to and made a part of ORS chapter 413.
 - SECTION 2. (1) As used in this section, "capacity" means the maximum number of members that a coordinated care organization may serve as determined by the Oregon Health Authority in accordance with ORS 414.645 (1).
 - (2) The authority may determine that there is a need to change a geographic area served by a coordinated care organization and solicit applications from other coordinated care organizations to expand into the geographic area already served by the coordinated care organization only if:
- 15 (a) The coordinated care organization already serving the ge-16 ographic area withdraws from all or a portion of the geographic area; 17 and
 - (b) Other coordinated care organizations operating in the same geographic area do not have adequate capacity to enroll the members affected by the coordinated care organization's withdrawal from all or

l	part of the geographic area.
2	SECTION 3. This 2016 Act being necessary for the immediate pres-
3	ervation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is de-
4	clared to exist, and this 2016 Act takes effect on its passage.
