Recognizes and honors Private George Nathan Wright (1945-1967) and Specialist Four James Alfred Wright (1948-1969) for their service to their country.

CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

Whereas Private George Nathan Wright was born on September 19, 1945;
and

Whereas Specialist Four James Alfred Wright was born on January 14,
1948; and

Whereas the Wright brothers and their family resided in Boring, Oregon;
and

Whereas Private George Nathan Wright was a United States Marine assigned to F Company, 2nd Battalion, 3rd Marine Regiment, 3rd Marine Division, III Marine Amphibious Force; and

Whereas Private George Nathan Wright was a 0311 Rifleman; and

Whereas Private George Nathan Wright succumbed to hostile enemy fire in Quang Tri Province, South Vietnam, on May 21, 1967, at the age of 21;
and

Whereas Specialist Four James Alfred Wright was a soldier in the United States Army assigned to B Battery, 6th Battalion, 11th Artillery, 11th Infantry Brigade, Americal Division; and

Whereas Specialist Four James Alfred Wright was a 13E40 Cannon Fire Direction Specialist; and

Whereas Specialist Four James Alfred Wright succumbed to hostile enemy

1 fire in Quang Ngai Province, South Vietnam, on May 31, 1969, at the age
2 of 21; and

3 Whereas the Wright family of Boring, Oregon, is one of only 41 families
4 nationwide to lose two sons in the Vietnam War; and

5 Whereas the father of the Wright brothers, George Wright, is a United
6 States Navy World War II veteran; and

7 Whereas the community of Boring and the Vietnam Veterans of America
8 wish to honor the sacrifice of the Wright family in the Vietnam War; now,
9 therefore,

10 **Be It Resolved by the Legislative Assembly of the State of Oregon:**

11 That we, the members of the Seventy-eighth Legislative Assembly, recog-
12 nize and honor Private George Nathan Wright and Specialist Four James
13 Alfred Wright for their service to their country.
