SUMMARY

Prohibits performance of late-term sex-selective abortion. Declares emergency, effective on passage.

1	A BILL FOR AN ACT
2	Relating to sex-selective abortions; and declaring an emergency.
3	Whereas sex-selective abortions are abortions performed solely because
4	of the known or suspected sex of an unborn child; and
5	Whereas sex-selective abortions are often performed because of personal
6	or cultural preferences for male children over female children, and not be-
7	cause of any clear or imminent danger to the life of the mother; and
8	Whereas scholarly research has demonstrated that sex-selective abortions
9	are discriminatory, as females are aborted in such procedures at a dispro-
10	portionately higher rate than are males; and
11	Whereas Oregonians strongly believe in gender equality; and
12	Whereas sex-selective abortions deprive unborn children of their natural
13	rights to life, liberty and the pursuit of happiness as described in the Dec-
14	laration of Independence and as protected by the United States Constitution;
15	now, therefore,
16	Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
17	SECTION 1. (1) As used in this section, "late-term sex-selective
18	abortion" means an abortion performed during the third trimester of
19	pregnancy and undertaken solely because of the known or suspected
