## **SUMMARY**

Honors Portland Timbers for their 2015 MLS Cup victory.

1	CONCURRENT RESOLUTION
2	Whereas the Portland Timbers earned their first Major League Soccer
3	(MLS) championship on December 6, 2015, capturing the 2015 MLS Cup tro-
4	phy with a 2 to 1 victory over Columbus Crew SC; and
5	Whereas team owner Merritt Paulson, recognizing Portland's potential
6	as an MLS powerhouse, has steered the development of both the Portland
7	Timbers and their home stadium, Providence Park, to excellence; and
8	Whereas throughout the season the Portland Timbers were spurred to
9	victory by the rousing cheers of the Timbers Army and the team's legion of
10	supporters who have filled Providence Park to capacity for every regular-
11	season and playoff match since the Portland Timbers' inaugural MLS season;
12	and
13	Whereas led by head coach Caleb Porter, the Portland Timbers finished
14	a winning season that landed them third in the Western Conference, a
15	placement that earned them the right to advance to the MLS Cup Playoffs;
16	and
17	Whereas the Portland Timbers progressed without a loss in their post-
18	season playoff march to win the cup final, defeating Sporting Kansas City,
19	Vancouver Whitecaps FC, FC Dallas and Columbus Crew SC; and
20	Whereas 27 seconds into the match Diego Valeri scored, breaking the re-
21	cord for the fastest goal in MLS Cup history and securing for himself the
22	2015 MLS Cup MVP award; and
