

**ORS SECTIONS AMENDED, REPEALED OR “ADDED TO”**

From left to right in the columns of the table below are found:

(1) The section, series of sections or chapter of Oregon Revised Statutes.

(2) An “A” or an “R” indicating respectively the amendment or repeal of the ORS section, or the word “Add” indicating that a section or sections of a measure are “added to and made a part of” the ORS chapter or series.

(3) The following information about the section and measure by which ORS is amended, repealed or “added to”:

(a) The section number and Senate or House measure number;

(b) The section number and current session measure number or previous session measure number if a measure was repassed over the Governor’s veto, followed by “OV” for a current session overturned veto or “OVP” for a previous session overturned veto; or

(c) The section number and boldfaced ballot measure number if an initiative petition was approved at the most recent general election (such as “§5 BM 55”).

The engrossing level is printed next to the measure number if the measure has been engrossed (such as “C” to indicate the C-engrossed version, “AMR” or “AMR2” to indicate respectively the first or second minority report A-engrossed version, and “BCC” or “BCC2” to indicate respectively the first or second conference committee report or amendment to the B-engrossed version).

The measure number and engrossing level appear in boldfaced type if the measure has become law, or has been referred, and has been assigned an Oregon Laws chapter number.

(4) An “E” if an emergency clause applies to the amendment, repeal or addition.
