SJR 202 By Senator KRUSE (Pre-session filed.) – Proposing amendment to Oregon Constitution relating to the creation of the State Board of Education.

Proposes amendment to Oregon Constitution creating State Board of Education.

SJR 203 By Senator PROZANSKI; Representatives BARNHART, HOLVEY, HOYLE, NATHANSON (Pre-session filed.) – Proposing amendment to Oregon Constitution relating to employment of person serving as judge.

2-3(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

Rescinds Senate Joint Resolution 34 (2013).

SJR 204 By Senator BOQUIST (Pre-session filed.) – Proposing amendment to Oregon Constitution relating to state finance.

2-3(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

Designates Clatsop Community College as Oregon's Maritime College.

SENATE BILLS

SB 1501 By Senator MONROE (Pre-session filed.) – Relating to energy savings performance contracts; declaring an emergency.

2-3(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

Exempts energy savings performance contracts, under certain circumstances, from requirement to use competitive bidding process to award public improvement contracts.

SB 1502 By Senator JOHNSON (Pre-session filed.) – Relating to transportation.

2-3(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

Requires Department of Transportation to study development of uniform speed bump height and markings.

SB 1503 Printed pursuant to Senate Interim Rule 213.28 by order of the President of the Senate in conformance with pre-session filing rules, indicating neither advocacy nor opposition on the part of the President. (at the request of Senate Interim Committee on Rules and Executive Appointments) - - Relating to elections.

2-3(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

Requires name of candidate for more than one district office that is to be filled at same election to be separately printed on official or special election ballot for each district office for which person is candidate.

SB 1504 Printed pursuant to Senate Interim Rule 213.28 by order of the President of the Senate in conformance with pre-session filing rules, indicating neither advocacy nor opposition on the part of the President. (at the request of Senate Interim Committee on Rules and Executive Appointments) - - Relating to elections.

2-3(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

Expands list of prior violations that prohibit individual from becoming circulator.

SB 1505 Printed pursuant to Senate Interim Rule 213.28 by order of the President of the Senate in conformance with pre-session filing rules, indicating neither advocacy nor opposition on the part of the President. (at the request of Senate Interim Committee on Veterans and Emergency Preparedness) – Relating to calculation of spousal support.

2-3(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

Excludes veterans' disability benefits from calculation of spousal support awards in family law proceedings.

SB 1506 Printed pursuant to Senate Interim Rule 213.28 by order of the President of the Senate in conformance with pre-session filing rules, indicating neither advocacy nor opposition on the part of the President. (at the request of Senate Interim Committee on Veterans and Emergency Preparedness) – Relating to education of children of military families.

2-3(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

Enacts Interstate Compact on Educational Opportunity for Military Children..

SB 1507 Printed pursuant to Senate Interim Rule 213.28 by order of the President of the Senate in conformance with pre-session filing rules, indicating neither advocacy nor opposition on the part of the President. (at the request of Senate Interim Committee on Veterans and Emergency Preparedness) – Relating to state financial administration; appropriating money; declaring an emergency.

2-3(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

Appropriates moneys from General Fund to Department of Justice for various public safety purposes.

SB 1508 By Senator MONNES ANDERSON (Pre-session filed.) – Relating to sex offenders; declaring an emergency.

2-3(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

Modifies sex offender registration requirements to allow sex offender to register with city police department only if offender last resided or intends to reside in city or, if offender lives out of state, only if offender attends school or works in city.

SB 1509 By Senators KRUSE, GIROD (Pre-session filed.) – Relating to school mascots; declaring an emergency.

2-3(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

Permits district school board to enter into written agreement with federally recognized Native American tribe in Oregon to identify acceptable name, symbol or image of mascot that represents or is associated with Native American tribe, to identify behavior expectations at athletic events and to identify required training on cultural diversity.

SB 1510 Printed pursuant to Senate Interim Rule 213.28 by order of the President of the Senate in conformance with pre-session filing rules, indicating neither advocacy nor opposition on the part of the President. (at the request of Senate Interim Committee on Environment and Natural Resources) – Relating to projects of statewide environmental significance.

2-3(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

Authorizes agencies of executive department, upon receipt of application for discretionary state permit for proposed action, to nominate proposed action to Economic Recovery and Environmental Review Council for enhanced review as project of statewide environmental significance.

SB 1511 Printed pursuant to Senate Interim Rule 213.28 by order of the President of the Senate in conformance with pre-session filing rules, indicating neither advocacy nor opposition on the part of the President. (at the request of Senate Interim Committee on Environment and Natural Resources) – Relating to radon.

2-3(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

Prohibits engaging in business of radon level testing or radon mitigation work without Department of Consumer and Business Services certification.

SB 1512 Printed pursuant to Senate Interim Rule 213.28 by order of the President of the Senate in conformance with pre-session filing rules, indicating neither advocacy nor opposition on the part of the President. (at the request of Senate Interim Committee on Environment and Natural Resources) – Relating to alterations in determined water rights in the Klamath Basin.

2-3(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

Makes Klamath Basin water right determined and established in order of determination existing water right for purposes of statute governing leasing of existing water rights for in-stream use.

SB 1513 Printed pursuant to Senate Interim Rule 213.28 by order of the President of the Senate in conformance with pre-session filing rules, indicating neither advocacy nor opposition on the part of the President. (at the request of Senate Interim Committee on Rural Communities and Economic Development) – Relating to reforestation; appropriating money; prescribing an effective date.

2-3(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

Establishes cost assistance program for reforestation of small woodlands following loss from catastrophic fire event.

SB 1514 Printed pursuant to Senate Interim Rule 213.28 by order of the President of the Senate in conformance with pre-session filing rules, indicating neither advocacy nor opposition on the part of the President. (at the request of Senate Interim Committee on Rural Communities and Economic Development) – Relating to the distribution of moneys to counties from the State Parks and Recreation Department Fund; declaring an emergency.

2-3(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

Until July 1, 2015, increases percentage of moneys distributed for county parks from 35 percent to 40 percent of moneys transferred to State Parks and Recreation Department from registration of travel trailers, campers and motor homes and from recreational vehicle trip permits.

SB 1515 By Senator STARR; Senator BEYER (Pre-session filed.) – Relating to elections; declaring an emergency.

2-3(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

Establishes work group to examine feasibility of Internet voting.

SB 1516 Printed pursuant to Senate Interim Rule 213.28 by order of the President of the Senate in conformance with pre-session filing rules, indicating neither advocacy nor opposition on the part of the President. (at the request of Senate Interim Committee on Rural Communities and Economic Development) – Relating to the Salmonberry Trail; appropriating money; declaring an emergency.

2-3(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

Requires development of plan for Salmonberry Trail.

SB 1517 By Senator COURTNEY (Pre-session filed.) – Relating to sex offenders.

2-3(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

Increases penalties for certain sex crimes when specified criteria proven to jury.

SB 1518 By Senator COURTNEY (Pre-session filed.) – Relating to supervisory employees under collective bargaining law; declaring an emergency.

2-3(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

Modifies definition of "supervisory employee" for purposes of public employee collective bargaining law.

SB 1519 By Senators GIROD, BATES, Representatives ESQUIVEL, BUCKLEY (Pre-session filed.) – Relating to dentistry; declaring an emergency.

2-3(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

Requires dentist to test, at least once per week, autoclave or other heat sterilization device.

SB 1520 By Senator STARR (Pre-session filed.) – Relating to securities registration for renewable energy cooperative corporations; declaring an emergency.

2-3(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

Exempts from registration securities that renewable energy cooperative corporation issues to cooperative corporation members as evidence of membership in cooperative corporation or to show members' respective interests in assets, reserves or patronage dividends.

SB 1521 Printed pursuant to Senate Interim Rule 213.28 by order of the President of the Senate in conformance with pre-session filing rules, indicating neither advocacy nor opposition on the part of the President. (at the request of Senate Interim Committee on General Government, Consumer and Small Business Protection) – Relating to commercial interior design; appropriating money; declaring an emergency.

2-3(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

Establishes Board of Commercial Interior Design.

SB 1522 Printed pursuant to Senate Interim Rule 213.28 by order of the President of the Senate in conformance with pre-session filing rules, indicating neither advocacy nor opposition on the part of the President. (at the request of Senate Interim Committee on General Government, Consumer and Small Business Protection) – Relating to motor vehicle registration plate surveillance cameras.

2-3(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

Restricts use of motor vehicle registration plate surveillance cameras.

SB 1523 Printed pursuant to Senate Interim Rule 213.28 by order of the President of the Senate in conformance with pre-session filing rules, indicating neither advocacy nor opposition on the part of the President. (at the request of Senate Interim Committee on General Government, Consumer and Small Business Protection) – Relating to health care coverage; declaring an emergency.

2-3(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

Requires coverage of applied behavior analysis and treatment of children with pervasive developmental disorder by self-insured plans offered by Public Employees' Benefit Board, Oregon Educators Benefit Board and Oregon Health and Science University.

SB 1524 Printed pursuant to Senate Interim Rule 213.28 by order of the President of the Senate in conformance with pre-session filing rules, indicating neither advocacy nor opposition on the part of the President. (at the request of Senate Interim Committee on Education and Workforce Development) – Relating to community college costs; declaring an emergency.

2-3(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

Directs Higher Education Coordinating Commission to examine viability of program allowing students who graduated from high school in state to attend community college for specified period without paying tuition and fees.

SB 1525 Printed pursuant to Senate Interim Rule 213.28 by order of the President of the Senate in conformance with pre-session filing rules, indicating neither advocacy nor opposition on the part of the President. (at the request of Senate Interim Committee on Education and Workforce Development) – Relating to education; declaring an emergency.

2-3(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

Grants Higher Education Coordinating Commission authority to enter into and administer interstate agreements regarding provision of post-secondary distance education.

SB 1526 By Senator STEINER HAYWARD; Senators BATES, MONNES ANDERSON, Representatives GOMBERG, GREENLICK, NATHANSON (Pre-session filed.) – Relating to children's health care coverage; declaring an emergency.

2-3(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

Requires Oregon Health Authority to request federal approval to use Children's Health Insurance Program funds to subsidize costs of commercial health insurance coverage for children with family incomes from 200 percent to 300 percent of federal poverty guidelines.

SB 1527 By Senator DEVLIN, Representative GALLEGOS (Pre-session filed.) – Relating to dislocated worker training program; appropriating money; declaring an emergency.

2-3(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

Directs Oregon Business Development Department to contract with private or public entities to develop Dislocated Worker Training Program as pilot program to enable unemployed and underemployed engineers and industry professionals in bioscience and manufacturing traded sector industries to be reemployed in Oregon.

SB 1528 By Senators MONROE, KRUSE, Representative HOYLE; Senators DEVLIN, GIROD, ROBLAN, Representatives BUCKLEY, GELSNER, KOMP (Pre-session filed.) – Relating to funding for education of students in treatment programs; appropriating money; prescribing an effective date.

2-3(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

Alters method by which moneys are distributed to school districts for purpose of paying for costs of education of students in eligible day treatment programs and eligible residential treatment programs.

SB 1529 By Senator OLSEN (Pre-session filed.) – Relating to the amendment of legislative measures.

2-3(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

Requires name of member or committee of Legislative Assembly requesting set of proposed amendments to legislative measure to be identified on proposed amendments.

SB 1530 By Senators OLSEN, CLOSE (Pre-session filed.) – Relating to reductions in taxes; prescribing an effective date.

2-3(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

Modifies provisions allowing for optional reduced rates of personal income tax on nonpassive income.

SB 1531 By Senators HANSELL, MONROE; Senators BAERTSCHIGER JR, BOQUIST, CLOSE, FERRIOLI, GIROD, JOHNSON, KNOPP, KRUSE, OLSEN, THOMSEN, WHITSETT, WINTERS, Representatives ESQUIVEL, JENSON, THOMPSON, WHISNANT (at the request of Association of Oregon Counties and League of Oregon Cities) (Pre-session filed.) – Relating to marijuana facilities; declaring an emergency.

2-3(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

Specifies that governing body of city or county may regulate or restrict operation of medical marijuana facility, prohibit registration of medical marijuana facility, or regulate, restrict or prohibit storing or dispensing of marijuana by facility legally authorized to store or dispense marijuana.

SB 1532 By Senators STEINER HAYWARD, DEVLIN, Representative DAVIS; Senators BEYER, ROBLAN, STARR, Representative BARKER (Pre-session filed.) – Relating to strategic investment; prescribing an effective date.

2-3(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

For purposes of transfer to Shared Services Fund, requires Oregon Department of Administrative Services to state separately personal income tax revenue attributable to new jobs and retained jobs.

SB 1533 Printed pursuant to Senate Interim Rule 213.28 by order of the President of the Senate in conformance with pre-session filing rules, indicating neither advocacy nor opposition on the part of the President. (at the request of Senate Interim Committee on Finance and Revenue) – Relating to taxation of telecommunications services; prescribing an effective date.

2-3(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

Directs Legislative Revenue Officer to conduct study of local government taxation of telecommunications service providers and propose method of taxation that taxes competitors uniformly and is acceptable to local governments.

SB 1534 Printed pursuant to Senate Interim Rule 213.28 by order of the President of the Senate in conformance with pre-session filing rules, indicating neither advocacy nor opposition on the part of the President. (at the request of Senate Interim Committee on Finance and Revenue) – Relating to taxation; prescribing an effective date.

2-3(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

Makes corrections to provisions related to income tax subtraction for senior medical expenses, tax treatment of domestic international sales corporations and distribution of proceeds from cigarette tax.

SB 1535 Printed pursuant to Senate Interim Rule 213.28 by order of the President of the Senate in conformance with pre-session filing rules, indicating neither advocacy nor opposition on the part of the President. (at the request of Senate Interim Committee on Finance and Revenue) – Relating to public investing; declaring an emergency.

2-3(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

Limits investment of local government funds to statutory investment pool for local and tribal government funds.

SB 1536 Printed pursuant to Senate Interim Rule 213.28 by order of the President of the Senate in conformance with pre-session filing rules, indicating neither advocacy nor opposition on the part of the President. (at the request of Oregon Judicial

Department) -- Relating to disclosure of certain court records in proceedings involving children; declaring an emergency.

2-3(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

Clarifies statutes regarding maintaining and access to "record of the case" and "supplemental confidential file" in juvenile court proceedings.

SB 1537 By Senator BEYER (Pre-session filed.) -- Relating to mutual wagering.

2-3(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

Provides that mutual pool for live or previously held horse race may include unclaimed amounts carried forward from mutual pool from previous races.

SB 1538 By Senators HASS, KRUSE (at the request of Portland Public Schools) (Pre-session filed.) -- Relating to public charter schools.

2-3(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

Allows school district board to place limitations on proposals for public charter schools that board will evaluate if specified percentage of students of school district are enrolled in public charter schools and specified number of public charter schools are located in school district.

SB 1539 By Senator WINTERS (Pre-session filed.) -- Relating to prescription drug coverage.

2-3(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

Imposes requirements on step therapy drug protocols required by specified persons that pay for or reimburse claims for prescription drugs.

SB 1540 By Senator WINTERS, Representative WILLIAMSON; Senators BOQUIST, CLOSE, DEVLIN, EDWARDS, FERRIOLI, GIROD, HANSELL, JOHNSON, KNOPP, MONROE, ROBLAN, STEINER HAYWARD, THOMSEN, WHITSETT, Representatives BARKER, BERGER, BUCKLEY, CAMERON, DOHERTY, FREDERICK, GALLEGOS, GELSER, GORSEK, KENY-GUYER, NATHANSON, PARRISH, THATCHER, VEGA PEDERSON, WEIDNER, WITT (Pre-session filed.) -- Relating to bad-faith assertions of patent infringement; declaring an emergency.

2-3(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

Prohibits person or person's affiliate from communicating demand to recipient if in demand person or affiliate alleges, asserts or claims in bad faith that recipient has infringed or contributed to infringing patent or rights that patentee, assignee or licensee has under patent.

SB 1541 By Senators THOMSEN, BURDICK, JOHNSON, Representatives PARRISH, WITT; Senators BAERTSCHIGER JR, DEMBROW, HANSELL, KRUSE, MONNES ANDERSON, OLSEN, ROBLAN, ROSENBAUM, STEINER HAYWARD, WHITSETT, Representatives BAILEY, BARTON, BENTZ, BOONE, CAMERON, DAVIS, DOHERTY, GELSER, GILLIAM, HICKS, HOYLE, JOHNSON, KENNEMER, KENY-GUYER, KOMP, MCKEOWN, REARDON, RICHARDSON, SPRENGER, WHISNANT, WILLIAMSON (Pre-session filed.) -- Relating to tax credits for crop donation; prescribing an effective date.

2-3(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

Extends sunset for tax credit for crop donation.

SB 1542 By Senators ROSENBAUM, BEYER, STEINER HAYWARD, Representative GALLEGOS; Senators DEMBROW, MONNES ANDERSON, Representatives BARKER, CLEM, GORSEK, KENY-GUYER, SMITH WARNER (Pre-session filed.) -- Relating to in-home care providers; declaring an emergency.

2-3(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

Allows private payers to hire home care workers through registry maintained by Home Care Commission.

SB 1543 By Senator DEMBROW; Senator MONNES ANDERSON, Representative KENY-GUYER (Pre-session filed.) -- Relating to employee health care coverage based on hours worked.

2-3(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

Makes reduction of hours worked by full-time employee for sole purpose of preventing employee's eligibility for coverage under Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act unlawful employment practice.

SB 1544 By Senator ROBLAN, Representative BERGER; Senators DEVLIN, EDWARDS, HANSELL, MONROE, OLSEN, ROSENBAUM, Representatives BARKER, BUCKLEY, FREDERICK, GALLEGOS, KENY-GUYER, KOMP, MCKEOWN, NATHANSON, OLSON, PARRISH, WITT (Pre-session filed.) -- Relating to Citizens' Initiative Review Commission; declaring an emergency.

2-3(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

Changes membership and meeting requirements of Citizens' Initiative Review Commission.

SB 1545 By Senators ROBLAN, KRUSE, Representative MCKEOWN; Representative WITT (Pre-session filed.) -- Relating to the Oregon Ocean Science Trust; declaring an emergency.

2-3(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

Adds two legislators as nonvoting members of Oregon Ocean Science Trust.

SB 1546 By Senator SHIELDS; Senators BEYER, BOQUIST, DEVLIN, MONNES ANDERSON, ROSENBAUM, STEINER HAYWARD, Representatives BARKER, BUCKLEY, GORSEK, KENNEMER, PARRISH, REARDON, WITT (at the request of United Food and Commercial Workers Local 555) (Pre-session filed.) -- Relating to allowing underage persons access to prohibited items; declaring an emergency.

2-3(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

Resolves terminology conflict to reflect that offense of endangering welfare of minor through distributing, selling or causing sale of tobacco to minor is Class A violation.

SB 1547 By Senator CLOSE; Senators BAERTSCHIGER JR, HANSELL, KNOPP, OLSEN, ROBLAN, Representatives OLSON, RICHARDSON, THATCHER, WEIDNER (Pre-session filed.) -- Relating to youth employment incentives for small businesses; appropriating money; declaring an emergency.

2-3(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

Authorizes county governing bodies and small business employers to enter into agreements for reimbursement of portion of wages paid to youth employees.

SB 1548 By Senators MONNES ANDERSON, KRUSE; Senators DEMBROW, KNOPP, Representative GILLIAM (Pre-session filed.) – Relating to mid-level health care practitioners; prescribing an effective date.

2-3(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

Amends certain statutes that reference "physician" to include references to "physician assistant" and "nurse practitioner."
Takes effect July 1, 2014.

SB 1549 By Senator BURDICK (at the request of Oregon Society of Certified Public Accountants) (Pre-session filed.) – Relating to the regulation of investigators; declaring an emergency.

2-3(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

Excepts persons authorized to engage in public accountancy in this state from provisions regulating investigators.

SB 1550 Printed pursuant to Senate Interim Rule 213.28 by order of the President of the Senate in conformance with pre-session filing rules, indicating neither advocacy nor opposition on the part of the President. (at the request of Senate Interim Committee on Judiciary) – Relating to crime; declaring an emergency.

2-3(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

Modifies crime of invasion of personal privacy.

SB 1551 Printed pursuant to Senate Interim Rule 213.28 by order of the President of the Senate in conformance with pre-session filing rules, indicating neither advocacy nor opposition on the part of the President. (at the request of Senate Interim Committee on Judiciary) – Relating to firearms.

2-3(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

Requires person to request criminal background check before transferring firearm to any other person.

SB 1552 Printed pursuant to Senate Interim Rule 213.28 by order of the President of the Senate in conformance with pre-session filing rules, indicating neither advocacy nor opposition on the part of the President. (at the request of Senate Interim Committee on Judiciary) – Relating to secured transactions in personal property; declaring an emergency.

2-3(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

Provides that record of financing statement sufficiently provides name of debtor who is individual when record provides individual name, or surname and first personal name, of debtor.

SB 1553 By Senator DEMBROW, Representative DOHERTY (Pre-session filed.) – Relating to services for persons with inadequate resources; appropriating money; declaring an emergency.

2-3(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

Directs Governor to appoint Oregon Public Guardian and Conservator in office of Long Term Care Ombudsman to provide public guardian and conservator services for persons without relatives or friends willing or able to serve as guardians or conservators.

SB 1554 By Senator FERRIOLI; Senators BAERTSCHIGER JR., BOQUIST, HANSELL, KNOPP, WHITSETT, WINTERS (Pre-session filed.) – Relating to county

education funding protection ordinances; prescribing an effective date.

2-3(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

Authorizes county to adopt education funding protection ordinance for up to 10 years if at least 50 percent by area of county is subject to certain exemption or special assessment programs under ad valorem property tax statutes or if county has population of 100,000 or less.

SB 1555 By Senators GIROD, BAERTSCHIGER JR; Senators BEYER, BOQUIST, CLOSE, EDWARDS, FERRIOLI, HANSELL, JOHNSON, KNOPP, KRUSE, OLSEN, ROBLAN, THOMSEN, WHITSETT, WINTERS, Representatives KRIEGER, WEIDNER (Pre-session filed.) – Relating to forest products; declaring an emergency.

2-3(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

Caps amount of bonds or other securities required of bidder or purchaser in connection with forest product sales by State Forester.

SB 1556 By Senator PROZANSKI, Representative BUCKLEY; Senators DEMBROW, STEINER HAYWARD, Representatives BARKER, BARNHART, FREDERICK, HOLVEY (Pre-session filed.) – Relating to marijuana; providing that this Act shall be referred to the people for their approval or rejection.

2-3(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

Declares that person 21 years of age or older legally should be able to possess, transfer or produce marijuana.

SB 1557 Printed pursuant to Senate Interim Rule 213.28 by order of the President of the Senate in conformance with pre-session filing rules, indicating neither advocacy nor opposition on the part of the President. (at the request of Senate Interim Committee on Business and Transportation) – Relating to offense of failure to provide clear title; declaring an emergency.

2-3(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

Specifies when vehicle dealer has received certificate of title or other primary ownership document for purpose of offense of failure to provide clear title.

SB 1558 Printed pursuant to Senate Interim Rule 213.28 by order of the President of the Senate in conformance with pre-session filing rules, indicating neither advocacy nor opposition on the part of the President. (at the request of Senate Interim Committee on Business and Transportation) – Relating to self-insurance coverage for workers' compensation claims; declaring an emergency.

2-3(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

Authorizes Director of Department of Consumer and Business Services to pay compensation due to workers of members of certain decertified self-insured employer groups and to set standards by rule for proof of financial viability of self-insured employer and for insurance coverage retention and combined net worth of members of self-insured employer group.

SB 1559 Printed pursuant to Senate Interim Rule 213.28 by order of the President of the Senate in conformance with pre-session filing rules, indicating neither advocacy nor opposition on the part of the President. (at the request of Senate Interim Committee on Business and Transportation) – Relating to alcoholic beverages; declaring an emergency.

2-3(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

Allows qualifying off-premises sales licensee to obtain endorsement authorizing sale of distilled liquor at licensed premises.

SB 1560 Printed pursuant to Senate Interim Rule 213.28 by order of the President of the Senate in conformance with pre-session filing rules, indicating neither advocacy nor opposition on the part of the President. (at the request of Senate Interim Committee on Health Care and Human Services) – Relating to telemedicine; declaring an emergency.

2-3(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

Modifies requirements for health plan coverage of telemedical services.

SB 1561 Printed pursuant to Senate Interim Rule 213.28 by order of the President of the Senate in conformance with pre-session filing rules, indicating neither advocacy nor opposition on the part of the President. (at the request of Senate Interim Committee on Health Care and Human Services) – Relating to drug outlets; declaring an emergency.

2-3(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

Exempts establishment where practitioner dispenses drugs from laws and rules related to regulation of drug outlets if establishment and practitioner meet certain criteria.

SB 1562 Printed pursuant to Senate Interim Rule 213.28 by order of the President of the Senate in conformance with pre-session filing rules, indicating neither advocacy nor opposition on the part of the President. (at the request of Senate Interim Committee on Health Care and Human Services) – Relating to health insurance.

2-3(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

Modifies requirements for health insurance coverage of services, medications and supplies necessary for management of diabetes during pregnancy.

SB 1563 By Senators ROSENBAUM, ROBLAN, BEYER; Senators COURTNEY, JOHNSON, STEINER HAYWARD, Representatives BARKER, DOHERTY, FREDERICK, GALLEGOS, GORSEK, KENY-GUYER, REARDON, WITT (Pre-session filed.) – Relating to entrepreneurial development; declaring an emergency.

2-3(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

Increases cap on entrepreneurial development loans from \$70,000 to \$100,000.

SB 1564 By Senator FERRIOLI (Pre-session filed.) – Relating to elections; declaring an emergency.

2-3(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

Establishes defective ballot boards to inspect ballots that cannot accurately be tallied by vote tally system.

SB 1565 By Senator BAERTSCHIGER JR; Senators BOQUIST, CLOSE, FERRIOLI, HANSELL, JOHNSON, KNOPP, OLSEN, THOMSEN, WHITSETT, WINTERS, Representative JOHNSON (Pre-session filed.) – Relating to discrimination; declaring an emergency.

2-3(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

Prohibits discrimination based on age, expected length of life, present or predicted disability, degree of medical dependency or quality of life in issuance of health benefit plans and in determination of medical services covered by state medical assistance program.

SB 1566 Printed pursuant to Senate Interim Rule 213.28 by order of the President of the Senate in conformance with pre-session filing rules, indicating neither advocacy nor opposition on the part of the President. (at the request of Governor John A. Kitzhaber, M.D.) – Relating to the State Workforce Investment Board; declaring an emergency.

2-3(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

Declares state public policy to promote coordinated provision of education, employment and job training.

SB 1567 Printed pursuant to Senate Interim Rule 213.28 by order of the President of the Senate in conformance with pre-session filing rules, indicating neither advocacy nor opposition on the part of the President. (at the request of Governor John A. Kitzhaber, M.D.) – Relating to management service employees.

2-3(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

Modifies reinstatement rights of management service employees who have immediate prior former regular status in classified service.

SB 1568 By Senator EDWARDS (Pre-session filed.) – Relating to Department of Revenue tax collections; prescribing an effective date.

2-3(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

Prohibits Department of Revenue from assigning tax debts to private collection agencies.

SB 1569 By Senator EDWARDS, Representatives KENY-GUYER, CONGER, THOMPSON; Representatives BERGER, GOMBERG (Pre-session filed.) – Relating to high priority chemicals of concern for children's health; appropriating money; declaring an emergency.

2-3(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

Requires Oregon Health Authority to establish and maintain list of designated high priority chemicals of concern for children's health used in children's products.

SB 1570 By Senator BEYER (Pre-session filed.) – Relating to low carbon fuel standards; declaring an emergency.

2-3(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

Repeals sunset on provisions related to low carbon fuel standards.

SB 1571 By Senator SHIELDS; Senators MONNES ANDERSON, PROZANSKI, ROSENBAUM, Representative BAILEY (Pre-session filed.) – Relating to restoration work.

2-3(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

Prohibits certain solicitation practices by construction contractors providing restoration work on residential or commercial property or contents following man-made or natural disaster.

SB 1572 By Senator WHITSETT; Senators BAERTSCHIGER JR, GIROD, HANSELL, JOHNSON, KRUSE, OLSEN, THOMSEN, WINTERS, Representatives ESQUIVEL, JENSON, KRIEGER, MCKEOWN, MCLANE

(Pre-session filed.) – Relating to procedures for regulating water rights; declaring an emergency.

2-3(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

Establishes standard for measuring distance between proposed or existing well and surface water source for purpose of determining probability or existence of impairment of, or substantial or undue interference with, existing rights of others to appropriate surface water.

SB 1573 By Senator WHITSETT; Senator OLSEN (Pre-session filed.) – Relating to tax reduction; prescribing an effective date.

2-3(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

Increases percentage of federal earned income credit allowed as credit against personal income taxes.

SB 1574 By Senator CLOSE (Pre-session filed.) – Relating to accelerated learning; declaring an emergency.

2-3(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

Modifies duties of Accelerated Learning Committee.

SB 1575 By Senator THOMSEN (Pre-session filed.) – Relating to utilizing raw logs in resource zones.

2-3(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

Allows establishment in forest zone or mixed farm and forest zone of facility for utilizing raw logs.

SB 1576 By Senator GEORGE, Representatives PARRISH, RICHARDSON; Senators BAERTSCHIGER JR, BOQUIST, CLOSE, FERRIOLI, HANSELL, KNOPP, KRUSE, STARR, WHITSETT, WINTERS, Representatives MCLANE, THATCHER (Pre-session filed.) – Relating to funding for educational options; appropriating money; declaring an emergency.

2-3(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

Establishes Oregon Empowerment Scholarship Program for purpose of providing options in education to students.

SB 1577 By Senators KNOPP, MONNES ANDERSON, CLOSE, Representatives TOMEL, PARRISH; Senators BAERTSCHIGER JR, FERRIOLI, HANSELL, HASS, KRUSE, ROBLAN, STEINER HAYWARD, THOMSEN, WHITSETT, WINTERS, Representatives GILLIAM, HUFFMAN, MCLANE, OLSON, WHISNANT (Pre-session filed.) – Relating to assistance; declaring an emergency.

2-3(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

Requires Department of State Police and all sheriffs and municipal police departments to adopt written policies relating to missing vulnerable adults on or before January 1, 2015.

SB 1578 By Senator KNOPP; Senators BAERTSCHIGER JR, BOQUIST, CLOSE, FERRIOLI, GEORGE, GIROD, HANSELL, KRUSE, OLSEN, THOMSEN, WHITSETT, WINTERS, Representatives HUFFMAN, MCLANE, WHISNANT (Pre-session filed.) – Relating to facilitation of economic development; prescribing an effective date.

2-3(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

Authorizes cities and counties to adopt ordinances for expedited siting of industrial, manufacturing or natural resource facilities in areas of high unemployment.

SB 1579 By Senator BATES (Pre-session filed.) – Relating to health insurance; declaring an emergency.

2-3(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

Requires certain health plans with prescription drug benefits to cover refills of prescription drugs in accordance with plan for synchronizing refill dates of patient's prescription drugs.

SB 1580 By Senator BATES (Pre-session filed.) – Relating to methadone clinics.

2-3(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

Prohibits methadone clinic from commencing operation at site within 1,000 feet of pediatric clinic or public park.

SB 1581 By Senator HASS; Representatives BARNHART, BUCKLEY, GALLEGOS, GELSER, GREENLICK, UNGER (at the request of Oregon Student Association) (Pre-session filed.) – Relating to voter registration.

2-3(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

Directs public universities and community colleges to increase voter registration access and information.

SB 1582 By Senator COURTNEY – Relating to administration of health insurance; declaring an emergency.

2-3(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

Authorizes Oregon Medical Insurance Pool Board to make expenditures for transitional medical insurance pool program.

SB 1583 By Senators GEORGE, SHIELDS, Representatives HUFFMAN, WILLIAMSON – Relating to privacy.

2-3(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

Prohibits public body from obtaining location information of cellular telephone or other electronic communication device without warrant, consent or certain emergent circumstances.

SB 1584 By Senators FERRIOLI, OLSEN, JOHNSON; Senator BOQUIST – Relating to applications for exotic animal permits; declaring an emergency.

2-3(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

Allows State Department of Agriculture to issue person permit for keeping of qualifying exotic animal.
