HOUSE BILLS

HB4013 By Representatives GREENLICK, THOMPSON, Senators MONNES ANDERSON, KRUSE (Pre-session filed.) – Relating to prescriptions; declaring an emergency.

- 2-3(H) First reading. Referred to Speaker's desk. Referred to Health Care. Public Hearing and Work Session held.

Authorizes practitioners to electronically transmit prescriptions for Schedule II controlled substances in nonemergency situations.

HB4045 Introduced and printed pursuant to House Rule 12.00. Pre-session filed (at the request of House Interim Committee on Agriculture and Natural Resources) – Relating to the Well Constructors Continuing Education Committee; declaring an emergency.

Exempts vessel ocean Dungeness crab permits from being subject to revocation or refusal of issuance by State Fish and Wildlife Commission or by court order under certain circumstances.

HB4056 By Representatives WHISNANT, HOYLE, GOMBERG; Representatives BERGER, BOONE, HICKS, MCLANE, THOMPSON, WHITSETT, Senator BOQUIST (Pre-session filed.) – Relating to documents recording a death that are in the custody of a county official; declaring an emergency.

Prohibits county clerk or county recording officer from recording document that records death filed in conjunction with owning or having interest in land if document originated in this state and includes medical information related to cause of death.
