Abolishes State Landscape Contractors Board.

Allows State Parks and Recreation Department to enter into agreement with Willamette River Channel Maintenance Group for performance of maintenance needed to improve river navigability and safety, to improve marine access to public parks, landings and other accesses and to encourage tourism and transportation.

Repeals moratorium on certain mining using any form of motorized equipment.

**SB 185** By Senator BOQUIST (at the request of Peggy Boquist) (Pre-session filed.) – Relating to social media accounts in employment.

1-12(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

Establishes unlawful employment practice of employer requiring employee or applicant for employment to establish and maintain personal social media account or to authorize employer to advertise on personal social media account of employee or applicant.

**SB 186** By Senators KNOPP, MONNES ANDERSON, STEINER HAYWARD (Pre-session filed.) – Relating to epinephrine; declaring an emergency.

Authorizes entity that Oregon Health Authority identifies as presenting risk of harm to individuals who have severe allergic response to allergens to acquire epinephrine and necessary paraphernalia for administration.

Imposes new requirements on continuing care retirement communities and residential facilities.

Directs each minor political party to ensure by rule that at least 10 percent of party members participate in party's nominating process.

compulsory school attendance; prescribing an effective date.

Decreases compulsory school age from seven to five years of age.

Increases annual fee imposed on public utilities and telecommunications providers for purpose of defraying costs of Public Utility Commission.

Requires nonprofit hospital to adopt formula meeting specified criteria for executive compensation.

1-12(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

Directs Department of Corrections to determine last-known address of inmates in custody of department and submit information to Secretary of State.

**SB 332** By Senator SHIELDS, Representative KENY-GUYER; Senators BATES, BURDICK, DEMBROW, MONROE, ROSENBAUM, Representatives BARNHART, BUCKLEY, FREDERICK, GREENLICK, NOSSE, SMITH WARNER (at the request of Jobs with Justice and 15 Now Oregon) (Pre-session filed.) – Relating to state preemption of local authority to set minimum wage standards; declaring an emergency.

1-12(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

Repeals state preemption of charter and statutory authority of local governments to set minimum wage requirements.

**SB 333** By Senator JOHNSON, Representative GOMBERG (at the request of Lincoln County Commissioner Bill Hall) (Pre-session filed.) – Relating to a day to celebrate the legacy of Governor Tom McCall.

1-12(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

Designates March 22 of each year as Tom McCall Day to commemorate Governor McCall and encourage school districts to educate children about Governor McCall's legacy.

**SB 334** By Senator JOHNSON (at the request of Columbia County Commissioner Earl Fisher) (Pre-session filed.) – Relating to disorderly conduct in court facilities.

1-12(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

Appropriates moneys from General Fund to Oregon Health Authority to establish parity in funding formula for school-based health centers.

**SB 337** By Senators MONNES ANDERSON, KRUSE; Senators ROBLAN, THOMSEN (Pre-session filed.) – Relating to state financial administration; declaring an emergency.

1-12(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

Appropriates moneys from General Fund to Oregon Health Authority to establish 11 new school-based health centers.

**SB 338** By Senators MONNES ANDERSON, KRUSE; Senators ROBLAN, THOMSEN (Pre-session filed.) – Relating to state financial administration; declaring an emergency.

1-12(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

Appropriates moneys from General Fund to Oregon Health Authority for planning and administration necessary to accommodate new school-based health centers.

**SB 339** By Senators MONNES ANDERSON, KRUSE, Representative NATHANSON; Senators DEVLIN, ROBLAN (Pre-session filed.) – Relating to school nursing; declaring an emergency.

1-12(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

Creates position of State School Nursing Consultant in Oregon Health Authority and specifies duties.

**SB 340** By Senators STEINER HAYWARD, MONNES ANDERSON (Pre-session filed.) – Relating to inhalants; declaring an emergency.

1-12(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

Defines "inhalant delivery system." Amends laws concerning sale of tobacco products to, and use of tobacco products by, minors so those laws equally apply to inhalant delivery systems.

**SB 341** Printed pursuant to Senate Interim Rule 213.28 by order of the President of the Senate in conformance with pre-session filing rules, indicating neither advocacy nor opposition on the part of the President. (at the request of Senate Interim Committee on Judiciary) – Relating to agri-tourism; declaring an emergency.

1-12(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

Permits affiant in small estate to open one or more deposit accounts in financial institution with funds of decedent upon which to withdraw funds to pay certain claims and expenses.

**SB 403** Printed pursuant to Senate Interim Rule 213.28 by order of the President of the Senate in conformance with pre-session filing rules, indicating neither advocacy nor opposition on the part of the President. (at the request of Senate Interim Committee on Judiciary) – Relating to placement of children in the custody of the Department of Human Services.

1-12(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

Limits consideration of "relatives" for purposes of placing child in custody of Department of Human Services to exclude certain putative fathers and paternal relatives.

**SB 404** Printed pursuant to Senate Interim Rule 213.28 by order of the President of the Senate in conformance with pre-session filing rules, indicating neither advocacy nor opposition on the part of the President. (at the request of Senate Interim Committee on Judiciary for Oregon Law Commission) – Relating to juveniles; declaring an emergency.

1-12(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

Directs Oregon Law Commission to study legal definition and status of juvenile delinquency judgments.

**SB 405** Printed pursuant to Senate Interim Rule 213.28 by order of the President of the Senate in conformance with pre-session filing rules, indicating neither advocacy nor opposition on the part of the President. (at the request of Senate Interim Committee on Judiciary for Oregon Law Commission) – Relating to juvenile court records; declaring an emergency.

Creates Task Force on Juvenile Court Records.

**SB 406** Printed pursuant to Senate Interim Rule 213.28 by order of the President of the Senate in conformance with pre-session filing rules, indicating neither advocacy nor opposition on the part of the President. (at the request of Senate Interim Committee on Judiciary for Oregon Law Commission) – Relating to conduct of elections; declaring an emergency.

Directs Oregon Law Commission to conduct analysis and determine updates to ORS chapter 254 necessary to improve effectiveness and efficiency of conduct of elections.

**SB 407** Printed pursuant to Senate Interim Rule 213.28 by order of the President of the Senate in conformance with pre-session filing rules, indicating neither advocacy nor opposition on the part of the President. (at the request of Senate Interim Committee on Judiciary) – Relating to assaulting a law enforcement animal.

Increases penalty for crime of assaulting law enforcement animal when person causes death of animal.

**SB 408** By Senators MONNES ANDERSON, OLSEN, HANSELL, THOMSEN, Representative KENNEMER; Senators BAERTSCHIGER JR, BEYER, BOQUIST, DEMBROW, EDWARDS, FERRIOLI, JOHNSON, KNOPP, KRUSE, MONROE, ROBLAN, ROSENBAUM, THATCHER, WINTERS, Representatives BENTZ, BOONE, BUCKLEY, ESQUIVEL, FAGAN, HOYLE, HUFFMAN, JOHNSON, OLSON, PARRISH, SMITH WARNER, WHITSETT, WITT (Pre-session filed.) – Relating to state financial administration; declaring an emergency.

1-12(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

Appropriates moneys from General Fund to Oregon Military Department for Oregon Military Museum.

**SB 409** By Senator DEVLIN (Pre-session filed.) – Relating to noneconomic damages.

1-12(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

Repeals \$500,000 limit on noneconomic damages recoverable in wrongful death actions and other statutorily created causes of action.

**SB 410** By Senator DEVLIN (Pre-session filed.) – Relating to joint legislative committees.

1-12(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

Requires cochairs of Joint Committee on Ways and Means to serve as cochairs of Joint Legislative Audit Committee.

**SB 411** By Senators GELSER, ROSENBAUM (Pre-session filed.) – Relating to personal injury protection benefits.

1-12(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

Requires insurer to pay claims up to maximum coverage under policy of uninsured motorist coverage based on insured's total damages for personal injuries, less amounts recovered from other motor vehicle liability insurance policies.

**SB 412** By Senator ROBLAN (Pre-session filed.) – Relating to solid waste.

1-12(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

Defines conditions when rock, gravel, sand, silt and other similar material removed from waters of state are and are not solid waste.

**SB 413** By Senator BOQUIST (at the request of Elizabeth Crouch for Roy Fast) (Pre-session filed.) – Relating to assault in the first degree.

1-12(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

Directs Oregon Criminal Justice Commission to classify assault causing serious physical injury to child under six years of age as crime category 11.

**SB 414** By Senator ROBLAN, Representative GORSEK; Senators DEMBROW, EDWARDS, MONROE, PROZANSKI, ROSENBAUM, Representatives FAGAN, FREDERICK, GOMBERG, HOLVEY, SMITH WARNER (Pre-session filed.) – Relating to analyses required before conducting a procurement for services; declaring an emergency.

1-12(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

Permits employee of contracting agency that conducts cost analysis or determines feasibility of procurement, or exclusive representative of employee's bargaining unit, to seek judicial review of cost analysis or determination.

**SB 415** By Senators MONNES ANDERSON, STEINER HAYWARD (Pre-session filed.) – Relating to flavored tobacco products; declaring an emergency.

1-12(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

Prohibits distributing, selling or allowing to be sold flavored tobacco products or flavored inhalant delivery system products in this state.

**SB 416** By Senator STEINER HAYWARD; Senators BATES, MONNES ANDERSON, Representatives HELM, TAYLOR (Pre-session filed.) – Relating to the imposition of fees on entities subject to the Oregon Indoor Clean Air Act; declaring an emergency.

1-12(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

Requires payment of fee for smoke shop certification, renewal of smoke shop certification, transfer of smoke shop certification and relocation of smoke shop.

**SB 417** By Senator STEINER HAYWARD; Senators BATES, MONNES ANDERSON, Representatives HELM, TAYLOR (Pre-session filed.) – Relating to retail sale of products used to deliver substances into a person's respiratory system; declaring an emergency.

1-12(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

Requires premises where person makes retail sales of tobacco products and inhalant delivery systems to be licensed by Oregon Liquor Control Commission.

**SB 418** By Senator KNOPP (Pre-session filed.) – Relating to education; declaring an emergency.

1-12(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

Directs State Board of Education to adopt specified standards related to student education records.

**SB 419** By Senator KRUSE (Pre-session filed.) – Relating to animal welfare.

1-12(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

Directs animal impounding facilities to work with animal rescue groups to facilitate adoption of animals.

**SB 420** By Senator KRUSE (Pre-session filed.) – Relating to unlawful passing.

1-12(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

Allows operators of motorcycles and mopeds to pass vehicles in same lane during traffic jams or slowdowns.

**SB 421** By Senator KRUSE (Pre-session filed.) – Relating to school nurses; declaring an emergency.

1-12(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

Directs Department of Education to conduct evaluation on methods to improve effectiveness of school nurses.

**SB 422** By Senator KRUSE (Pre-session filed.) – Relating to standing to appeal decisions about land use.

1-12(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

Modifies grant of exclusive jurisdiction to review decisions about land use.

Directs Water Resources Commission to study issue of standing in lawsuits relating to water.

Makes housekeeping changes to statutes relating to alcohol and drug treatment.

Reduces public purpose expenditure standard.

**SB 432** By Senator OLSEN (Pre-session filed.) – Relating to 9-1-1 emergency communications; declaring an emergency.

1-12(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

Requires moneys in Emergency Communications Account, including Enhanced 9-1-1 Subaccount, to be used for purposes of 9-1-1 emergency communications unless statutory exception is made during state of fiscal emergency.

**SB 433** By Senator OLSEN (Pre-session filed.) – Relating to decreases in capital gains tax rates; prescribing an effective date.

Reduces rate of tax on capital gains of personal income and corporate income and excise taxpayers.

Grants higher property tax exemption on property of veterans with service-connected disabilities of 100 percent.

Requires name of member or committee of Legislative Assembly requesting set of proposed amendments to legislative measure to be identified on proposed amendments.

Provides that if public body agrees to pay or provide benefit to retired employees other than payments required or provided for in statutes, public body must create separate accounts for funding of those benefits and make annual contributions to accounts in amounts necessary to amortize liability for benefits in 25 years or less.

Allows taxpayer to expense certain business assets for income or corporate excise tax purposes.

Establishes Outdoor Education Account for purpose of providing outdoor school programs.

**SB 440** By Senator STEINER HAYWARD (Pre-session filed.) – Relating to measuring the quality of health care; declaring an emergency.

1-12(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

Requires Oregon Health Policy Board to establish Health Plan Quality Metrics Committee to develop health outcome and quality measures for coordinated care organizations and plans offered by Public Employees' Benefit Board and Oregon Educators Benefit Board.

**SB 441** By Senator STEINER HAYWARD (Pre-session filed.) – Relating to property creditable to the Trust for Cultural Development Account; declaring an emergency.

1-12(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

Authorizes Trust for Cultural Development Board to solicit and accept gifts, bequests or devises of money, securities or other property.

**SB 442** By Senator STEINER HAYWARD; Senators MONNES ANDERSON, ROSENBAUM (Pre-session filed.) – Relating to submission of information necessary to decline immunizations; declaring an emergency.

1-12(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

Directs Oregon Health Authority to adopt by rule schedule requiring submission of document to school administrator for purposes of declining immunization if document on record does not include signature of health care practitioner verifying that parent has reviewed risks and benefits of immunization or certificate verifying that parent has completed vaccine educational module.

**SB 443** By Senator STEINER HAYWARD; Senators BATES, BURDICK, GIROD, HASS, KRUSE, MONNES ANDERSON (Pre-session filed.) – Relating to sex offenders.

1-12(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

Requires State Board of Parole and Post-Prison Supervision or supervisory authority to prohibit contact with member of victim's immediate family as condition of post-prison supervision or parole for person convicted of sex crime.

**SB 444** By Senator STEINER HAYWARD (Pre-session filed.) – Relating to housing; declaring an emergency.

1-12(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

Directs Housing and Community Services Department to submit report related to housing stabilization programs to interim legislative committees no later than July 1, 2016.

**SB 445** By Senator MONNES ANDERSON; Senators BOQUIST, DEVLIN, EDWARDS, STEINER HAYWARD, THOMSEN (Pre-session filed.) – Relating to disclosure of information to consumers of marijuana; declaring an emergency.

1-12(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

Requires medical marijuana facilities and marijuana retailers to post at facility or on premises of retail location notice of harmful effects of marijuana on pregnant women and potential for marijuana to cause birth defects.

**SB 446** By Senators DEVLIN, BOQUIST, WINTERS, PROZANSKI, KRUSE, Representatives DAVIS, WILLIAMSON, OLSON, BARKER; Representative BUCKLEY (at the request of Chief Justice Thomas Balmer and the Oregon Circuit Court Judges Association) (Pre-session filed.) – Relating to judges' salaries.

1-12(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

Provides for annual adjustment of judges' salaries based on Consumer Price Index.

**SB 447** By Senator DEVLIN, Representative FAGAN (at the request of Task Force on School Capital Improvement Planning) (Pre-session filed.) – Relating to funding for capital costs of school districts; declaring an emergency.

1-12(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

Establishes grant program to provide matching fund grants to school districts for capital costs of school districts.

**SB 448** By Senators FERRIOLI, ROBLAN (Pre-session filed.) – Relating to memoranda of understanding regarding adjudication of youth offenders in certain counties.

1-12(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

Permits presiding judge of seventh judicial district, with approval of Chief Justice of the Supreme Court, to enter into memorandum of understanding with Confederated Tribes of Warm Springs regarding adjudication and disposition of youths and youth offenders.

**SB 449** By Senator MONNES ANDERSON, Representative GOMBERG; Senators BOQUIST, STEINER HAYWARD, Representatives FREDERICK, SMITH WARNER (Pre-session filed.) – Relating to services for individuals with disabilities.

1-12(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

Creates Office for Deaf, Deaf-Blind and Hard of Hearing Services in Department of Human Services.

**SB 450** By Senator GIROD (Pre-session filed.) – Relating to State School Fund adjustments for children in poverty; declaring an emergency.

1-12(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

Increases weight allotted for children in poverty for purposes of State School Fund distributions.

**SB 451** By Senator GIROD (Pre-session filed.) – Relating to prudent maximum General Fund-supported debt; declaring an emergency.

1-12(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

Establishes prudent maximum amount of outstanding General Fund-supported debt as amount for which debt service due in biennium equals five percent of General Fund revenues estimated to be received in biennium.

**SB 452** By Senator GIROD (Pre-session filed.) – Relating to wind turbines.

1-12(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

Requires State Department of Energy to adopt rules requiring decommission, deconstruction and removal of certain wind towers and turbines within three years after permanent cessation of use of tower and turbine for generation of wind energy.

**SB 453** By Senator GIROD (Pre-session filed.) – Relating to county elections concerning methods of taking wildlife; providing for criminal sentence reduction that requires approval by a two-thirds majority.

1-12(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

Provides that county is exempt from applicability of statute banning use of dogs to hunt or pursue cougars if voters approve county measure proposed by initiative petition or referred to people by governing body of county.

**SB 454** By Senators ROSENBAUM, STEINER HAYWARD, Representatives HOYLE, VEGA PEDERSON; Senators BURDICK, DEMBROW, MONNES ANDERSON, MONROE, RILEY, Representatives BUCKLEY, FAGAN, FREDERICK, GALLEGOS, HELM, KENY-GUYER, LININGER, MCLAIN, NOSSE, SMITH WARNER, WILLIAMSON (Pre-session filed.) – Relating to mandatory provision of sick time.

1-12(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

Requires all employers to implement paid sick time for employees.

**SB 455** By Senator BEYER (Pre-session filed.) – Relating to transportation of persons by for-hire carriers.

1-12(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

Deregulates oversight of for-hire carriers of persons.

**SB 456** By Senator BEYER (Pre-session filed.) – Relating to the voluntary emission reduction program for natural gas utilities; declaring an emergency.

1-12(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

Clarifies that natural gas utility may receive additional incentives for projects approved by Public Utility Commission under voluntary emission reduction program.

**SB 457** By Senators PROZANSKI, KRUSE (Pre-session filed.) – Relating to condemnation of private property by natural gas companies; declaring an emergency.

1-12(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

Requires natural gas company, if company is condemning private property for purpose of laying pipeline, to make proposal to owner of property that includes offer to pay owner annual payment and certain other guarantees.

**SB 458** By Senator PROZANSKI (at the request of Jyoti Barnhart, Zoe Littlebury, Dawn Turbin and Elizabeth Wyley) (Pre-session filed.) – Relating to a day to commemorate Oregon statehood.

1-12(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

Designates February 14 of each year as Oregon Statehood Day.

**SB 459** By Senator PROZANSKI (at the request of Dean Kaufman) (Pre-session filed.) – Relating to highway speeds.

1-12(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

Increases interstate highway speed limit to 70 miles per hour for most vehicles.

**SB 460** By Senator PROZANSKI (Pre-session filed.) – Relating to marijuana; declaring an emergency.

1-12(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

Directs Oregon Health Authority to adopt rules providing for relocation of registered medical marijuana facility.

**SB 461** By Senator PROZANSKI (at the request of Debbie Summers) (Pre-session filed.) – Relating to photographs.

1-12(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

Permits person to get replacement driver license or driver permit if person dislikes photograph on current driver license or driver permit.

**SB 462** By Senator PROZANSKI (Pre-session filed.) – Relating to secured transactions in personal property; declaring an emergency.

1-12(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

Provides that record of mortgage is effective as financing statement if record satisfies requirements for financing statement and sufficiently provides name of debtor.

**SB 463** By Senator PROZANSKI (at the request of Wayne Allen, Eugene Municipal Court Judge) (Pre-session filed.) – Relating to vehicle windows.

1-12(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

Permits persons who have certain physical condition to use window tinting that is darker than otherwise allowed if person shows police officer prescription or letter on letterhead from physician or optometrist.

**SB 464** By Senator PROZANSKI (at the request of Sam Chapman) (Pre-session filed.) – Relating to extracting cannabinoids from the cannabis plant; declaring an emergency.

1-12(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

Prohibits registrant under the Oregon Medical Marijuana Act from processing cannabinoid extracts unless registrant is certified by Oregon Health Authority to process cannabinoid extracts.

**SB 465** By Senators PROZANSKI, KRUSE (at the request of Susan Morgan) (Pre-session filed.) – Relating to community mental health programs; declaring an emergency.

1-12(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

Specifies duties and liabilities of community mental health program with respect to commitment proceedings initiated for individuals with mental illness.

**SB 466** By Senator PROZANSKI (Pre-session filed.) – Relating to lawsuits; declaring an emergency.

1-12(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

Authorizes court, as part of settlement or judgment in class action, to approve process for payment of damages.

**SB 467** By Senator JOHNSON (at the request of Jeff Kemp) (Pre-session filed.) – Relating to property division in family law proceeding.

1-12(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

Clarifies that court must consider costs of sale of assets, taxes and costs in determination of fair market value of property in just and proper division of property in marital dissolution, separation or annulment proceeding.

**SB 468** By Senator DEMBROW; Senator PROZANSKI, Representatives DOHERTY, HOLVEY, NOSSE (at the request of Commissioner of the Bureau of Labor and Industries Brad Avakian) (Pre-session filed.) – Relating to authority of Commissioner of Bureau of Labor and Industries to issue warrants for certain debts.

1-12(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

Authorizes Commissioner of Bureau of Labor and Industries to issue warrants for collection of certain debts owed to bureau.

**SB 469** By Senator MONNES ANDERSON, Representative GREENLICK; Senators DEVLIN, ROSENBAUM, STEINER HAYWARD, Representatives KENNEMER, NOSSE (Pre-session filed.) – Relating to staffing of hospitals; declaring an emergency.

1-12(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

Makes changes to laws governing hospital nursing staff, including laws setting forth composition of hospital nurse staffing committees and laws governing content of written hospital-wide staffing plans.

**SB 470** By Senator DEMBROW; Senators BEYER, MONNES ANDERSON, MONROE, ROBLAN, Representatives BARNHART, BUCKLEY, FREDERICK, GOMBERG, GORSEK, GREENLICK, HOLVEY, KENY-GUYER (Pre-session filed.) – Relating to unemployment insurance benefits for certain educational institution employees.

1-12(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

Allows payment of unemployment insurance benefits to certain individuals performing services in other than instructional, research or principal administrative capacity for educational institutions for weeks of unemployment commencing between two successive academic years or during established and customary vacation period or holiday recess.

**SB 471** By Senators DEMBROW, MONNES ANDERSON, KRUSE; Senators JOHNSON, WINTERS, Representative OLSON (Pre-session filed.) – Relating to appointment of legal counsel for certain persons in protective proceedings.

1-12(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

Requires court to appoint legal counsel for respondent or protected person in protective proceeding under certain circumstances.

**SB 472** By Senator JOHNSON (at the request of Oregon State Capitol Foundation and Oregon Historical Society) (Pre-session filed.) – Relating to Pacific Wonderland registration plates.

1-12(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

Increases maximum number of Pacific Wonderland registration plates that may be issued.

**SB 473** By Senator GELSER, Representative NOSSE (Pre-session filed.) – Relating to identifying information at higher education institutions.

1-12(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

Requires each public university, community college or other institution of higher education to allow students, faculty and staff to identify sexual orientation on forms used to collect demographic data.

**SB 474** By Senator GELSER (Pre-session filed.) – Relating to dental business entities for children with special needs; declaring an emergency.

1-12(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

Allows certain nonprofit charitable corporations to own and operate dental clinics that serve children with special needs.

**SB 475** By Senator GELSER (Pre-session filed.) – Relating to youth care centers; declaring an emergency.

1-12(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

Provides that students in youth care center within detention facility are to receive educational services through Juvenile Detention Education Program.

**SB 476** By Senator EDWARDS (Pre-session filed.) – Relating to exemption from obtaining aquatic invasive species prevention permit for manually propelled boat owned by local government.

1-12(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

Exempts local government from requirement to obtain aquatic invasive species prevention permit for certain boats.

**SB 477** By Senator EDWARDS, Representative READ; Senators BATES, DEMBROW, MONROE, Representatives BUCKLEY, GALLEGOS, GORSEK (Pre-session filed.) – Relating to energy.

1-12(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

Requires electric companies to reduce allocation of electricity from coal-derived generating resources to zero on or before January 1, 2025, to customers of electric company that are located in this state.

**SB 478** By Senator EDWARDS, Representatives KENY-GUYER, GOMBERG; Senators GELSER, STEINER HAYWARD, Representative JOHNSON (Pre-session filed.) – Relating to high priority chemicals of concern for children's health; declaring an emergency.

1-12(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

Requires Oregon Health Authority to establish and maintain list of designated high priority chemicals of concern for children's health used in children's products and to periodically review and revise list.

**SB 479** By Senator EDWARDS (Pre-session filed.) – Relating to the clinical research of cannabis; declaring an emergency.

1-12(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

Creates Task Force on Clinical Research of Cannabis and directs task force to study and report on development of medical cannabis industry that provides patients with medical products that meet individual patient needs.

**SB 480** By Senator EDWARDS (Pre-session filed.) – Relating to the clinical research of cannabis.

1-12(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

Establishes as semi-independent state agency Clinical Research of Cannabis Board.

**SB 481** By Senator EDWARDS, Representative NATHANSON (Pre-session filed.) – Relating to a constituent issue database; declaring an emergency.

1-12(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

Requires Legislative Administrator to establish and maintain database to catalog issues reported by constituents to members of Legislative Assembly, state agencies or other public bodies.

**SB 482** By Senators EDWARDS, THOMSEN, Representative HOYLE; Representatives CLEM, OLSON (Pre-session filed.) – Relating to partnerships for manufacturing economic development.

1-12(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

Authorizes Oregon Business Development Department to appoint Pacific Northwest Manufacturing Partnership Advisory Committee to advise department regarding Pacific Northwest Manufacturing Partnership and manufacturing economic development in geographic regions located within Willamette Valley and Columbia River corridor.

**SB 483** By Senator EDWARDS (Pre-session filed.) – Relating to fees imposed by the Teacher Standards and Practices Commission.

1-12(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

Removes requirement of Teacher Standards and Practices Commission to charge additional fee when applicant fails to make timely application for renewal of license or registration.

**SB 484** By Senator EDWARDS (Pre-session filed.) – Relating to civics education; declaring an emergency.

1-12(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

Directs Department of Education to conduct evaluation on methods to improve civics education.

**SB 485** By Senator EDWARDS (Pre-session filed.) – Relating to judgments of the Oregon Tax Court; declaring an emergency.

1-12(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

Prohibits public body from publishing on Internet amount of tax court judgment if amount of judgment is less than \$50,000.

**SB 486** By Senators EDWARDS, THOMSEN (Pre-session filed.) – Relating to profiling in law enforcement investigatory activity.

1-12(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

Prohibits law enforcement agencies and officers from profiling based on specified personal characteristics or circumstances of individuals, except when characteristics or circumstances are tied to specific suspect description or credible information related to criminal incident or activity.

**SB 487** By Senator EDWARDS (Pre-session filed.) – Relating to terminations for performance as teacher; declaring an emergency.

1-12(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

Directs school district to forward documentation relating to charges resulting in teacher's termination for failure to meet performance standards or goals to Teacher Standards and Practices Commission for disclosure to potential educational employers.

**SB 488** By Senator EDWARDS (Pre-session filed.) – Relating to hand dryers.

1-12(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

Requires Director of Department of Consumer and Business Services to establish uniform standards for hand dryers installed in public restrooms, including standards that impose limit on decibel level of operating hand dryer.

**SB 489** By Senator EDWARDS (Pre-session filed.) – Relating to public assistance.

1-12(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

Prohibits use of Oregon Trail Card to purchase junk food.

**SB 490** By Senator EDWARDS (Pre-session filed.) – Relating to low-income communities; declaring an emergency.

1-12(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

Requires Department of Human Services to seek federal approval and funding to implement pilot program to increase purchase and consumption of fruits and vegetables by recipients of Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program benefits.

**SB 491** By Senator MONNES ANDERSON, Representative KOMP; Senators BOQUIST, BURDICK, DEVLIN, EDWARDS, HASS, THOMSEN (Pre-session filed.) – Relating to requirements in public contracting for compliance with pay equity provisions of state law; declaring an emergency.

1-12(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

Provides that state contracting agency may not prequalify prospective bidder or proposer for public contract for goods or services, or for public improvement contract, if prospective bidder or proposer employs 40 or more workers and if public contract has estimated contract price that exceeds \$500,000, unless prospective bidder or proposer submits certificate that shows completion of training program for compliance with pay equity provisions of state law.

**SB 492** By Senators MONNES ANDERSON, WINTERS, THOMSEN; Senators DEVLIN, KNOPP, STEINER HAYWARD, Representatives LININGER, VEGA PEDERSON (Pre-session filed.) – Relating to leave from work for victims of certain crimes.

1-12(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

Authorizes use of accrued sick leave or personal business leave by certain employees who are victims of domestic violence, harassment, sexual assault or stalking.

**SB 493** By Senator BATES (Pre-session filed.) – Relating to disbanding governing boards at public universities; declaring an emergency.

1-12(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

Removes ability of Governor to disband university governing board or force university to take other action if university fails to make timely compliance with conditions established when State Board of Higher Education endorsed governing board.

**SB 494** By Senator BATES (Pre-session filed.) – Relating to documents issued by Department of Transportation.

1-12(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

Permits person stationed outside of Oregon while serving in active duty military service to renew or replace driver license or driver permit without photograph if Department of Transportation does not have acceptable photograph on file.

**SB 495** By Senator BATES (Pre-session filed.) – Relating to exceptions to safety belt requirements.

1-12(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

Eliminates exception to safety belt laws that allows person to not use safety belt if all seating positions in vehicle are occupied.

**SB 496** By Senator DEVLIN (Pre-session filed.) – Relating to eligibility for benefits from Public Safety Memorial Fund.

1-12(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

Includes certain compensable workers' compensation claims as qualifying criteria for eligibility for benefits from Public Safety Memorial Fund.

**SB 497** By Senator EDWARDS (Pre-session filed.) – Relating to annexation of territory within urban growth boundary by city.

1-12(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

Requires annexation of territory within urban growth boundary by city or, if within Metro, by city designated by Metro, upon receipt of petition proposing annexation that is submitted by all owners of land within territory to be annexed..

**SB 498** By Senator EDWARDS (Pre-session filed.) -- Relating to annexation of territory by city.

1-12(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

Prohibits city from submitting question of annexation of territory to electors of city when owners of land in territory and at least 50 percent of electors in territory consent to annexation in writing and additional criteria are met.

**SB 499** By Senator OLSEN (Pre-session filed.) -- Relating to a nongovernmental entity that receives public purpose charge moneys; declaring an emergency.

1-12(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

Requires nongovernmental entity, as condition of receiving public purpose charge moneys, to be assessed by independent third party.
