SENATE BILLS

SB 578 By COMMITTEE ON BUSINESS AND TRANSPORTATION – Relating to electronic delivery of insurance policies.

2-5(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

Permits insurer, under specified conditions, to post insurance policy and endorsements on insurer's website in lieu of mailing or delivering insurance policy and endorsements to insured.

SB 579 By COMMITTEE ON BUSINESS AND TRANSPORTATION – Relating to incentives for increasing apprentice utilization on public improvements for state contracting agencies; declaring an emergency.

2-5(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

Requires state contracting agency that awards public improvement contract with contract price of more than \$5 million to require contractor to employ apprentices to perform 10 percent of work hours on public improvement that workers in apprenticeable occupations perform.

SB 580 By COMMITTEE ON BUSINESS AND TRANSPORTATION – Relating to landscaping.

2-5(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

Allows State Landscape Contractors Board to assess contested case proceeding costs to person requesting that claim filed against board licensee be resolved through contested case proceeding.

SB 581 By COMMITTEE ON BUSINESS AND TRANSPORTATION (at the request of Oregon Society of Certified Public Accountants) – Relating to fees for practice of accountancy; declaring an emergency.

2-5(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

Changes fee for application for or renewal of permit to practice public accountancy.

SB 582 By COMMITTEE ON BUSINESS AND TRANSPORTATION – Relating to credit unions.

2-5(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

Removes requirement that credit union apply and pay fee to Director of Department of Consumer and Business Services in order to open additional places of business.

SB 583 By COMMITTEE ON BUSINESS AND TRANSPORTATION – Relating to alcoholic beverages; declaring an emergency.

2-5(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

Allows brewery-public house licensee to also hold off-premises sales license under certain circumstances.

SB 584 By COMMITTEE ON WORKFORCE – Relating to certifications of disadvantaged business enterprises; declaring an emergency.

2-5(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

Directs public contracting agency to suspend right of certified disadvantaged minority, women or emerging small business enterprise to bid on or participate in public contract if certified disadvantaged minority, women or emerging small business enterprise fails to perform commercially useful function in public contract.

SB 585 By COMMITTEE ON WORKFORCE – Relating to vocational education; declaring an emergency.

2-5(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

Establishes State Apprenticeship Education and Training Fund and continuously appropriates moneys in fund to State Apprenticeship and Training Council and Bureau of Labor and Industries for specified purposes.

SB 586 By COMMITTEE ON WORKFORCE – Relating to the Youth Development Council.

2-5(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

Increases age of youth for whom Youth Development Council may oversee unified system of services from 20 years to 24 years.

SB 587 By Senator WHITSETT – Relating to attendance for State School Fund distributions; declaring an emergency.

2-5(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

Adjusts manner in which attendance is calculated for purposes of State School Fund distributions.

SB 588 By Senator ROBLAN – Relating to the legal status of public charter schools; declaring an emergency.

2-5(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

Allows school district and public charter school to be considered single legal entity for purpose of public charter school law if public charter school is only school in school district and other conditions are met.

SB 589 By Senator BOQUIST – Relating to statutory construction.

2-5(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

Amplifies materials that may be considered legislative history of statute.

SB 590 By COMMITTEE ON HUMAN SERVICES AND EARLY CHILDHOOD – Relating to appointment of court visitors for minor respondents in guardianship proceedings.

2-5(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

Directs court to appoint court visitor for minor respondent in guardianship proceeding where minor is more than 16 years of age and court determines there is likelihood that petition seeking guardianship of respondent as adult will be filed before respondent attains age of majority or as adult.

SB 591 By COMMITTEE ON HUMAN SERVICES AND EARLY CHILDHOOD – Relating to violation of duty to report abuse; declaring an emergency.

2-5(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

Establishes public policy that Department of Human Services employee whose employment is terminated for violating duty to report abuse is not eligible for reinstatement of employment with department.

SB 592 By COMMITTEE ON HUMAN SERVICES AND EARLY CHILDHOOD – Relating to affordable housing.

2-5(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

Repeals law that prevents local governments from imposing conditions on approved permits that effectively establish sales price for residential development or limit purchase to class or group of purchasers.

SB 593 By COMMITTEE ON HUMAN SERVICES AND EARLY CHILDHOOD – Relating to name changes in domestic relations proceedings; declaring an emergency.

2-5(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

Permits party that requested name change in proceeding for marital annulment, dissolution or separation to request entry of supplemental judgment or corrected judgment when court does not order name change in general judgment.

SB 594 By Senator BATES – Relating to credentialing of health care practitioners.

2-5(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

Provides that health care practitioner is not required to submit credentialing information to Oregon Health Authority for purposes related to credentialing program until occurrence of certain events, including passage of date by which authority by rule requires that type of health care practitioner to submit credentialing information to authority.

SB 595 By Senator BATES – Relating to credentialing of health care practitioners.

2-5(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

Authorizes Oregon Health Authority to impose civil penalties on credentialing organizations and health care practitioners who violate laws and rules governing credentialing program administered by authority.

SB 596 By COMMITTEE ON WORKFORCE – Relating to construction flagging contractors.

2-5(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

Requires person employing, contracting with or leasing services of construction flagger to obtain construction flagging contractor license.

SB 597 By COMMITTEE ON WORKFORCE – Relating to minimum wage rate; declaring an emergency.

2-5(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

Increases Oregon minimum wage rate in graduated steps to \$13.50 per hour by 2017.

SB 598 By COMMITTEE ON WORKFORCE – Relating to methods for improving apprenticeship; declaring an emergency.

2-5(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

Establishes Task Force on 21st Century Apprenticeship with 14 members appointed by President of Senate, Speaker of House of Representatives and Governor.
