For purposes of homestead property tax deferral program, creates exception to five-year ownership requirement for homestead if claimant for deferral moved to homestead from homestead granted deferral and of greater real market value than new homestead, sells prior homestead within one year of purchasing new homestead, satisfies lien against prior homestead for deferred amounts and provides written attestation that claimant incurred debt for not more than 80 percent of purchase price of new homes
