**HB2255** Introduced and printed pursuant to House Rule 12.00. Pre-session filed (at the request of House Interim Committee on Consumer Protection and Government Efficiency) – Relating to the ratio of state agency public employees to supervisory employees; declaring an emergency.

1-16 Referred to Consumer Protection and Government Effectiveness.  
4-14 Public Hearing and Work Session held.  
4-20 Without recommendation as to passage, be referred to Rules, then Ways and Means.  
Referred to Rules then to Ways and Means by order of the Speaker.  
6-1 Work Session held.  
6-2 Recommendation: Do pass with amendments, be printed A-Engrossed, and subsequent referral to Ways and Means be rescinded.  
Subsequent referral to Ways and Means rescinded by order of the Speaker.  
6-3 Second reading.  
6-4 Rules suspended. Carried over to June 8, 2015 Calendar.  
6-8 Third reading. Carried by Smith Warner. Passed.

This measure has minimal fiscal impact, no statement issued.

Suspends during 2015-2017 biennium application of requirement that state agencies attain 11 to 1 ratio of nonsupervisory employees to supervisory employees.
