**HB5046** Introduced and printed pursuant to House Rule 12.00. Pre-session filed (at the request of Oregon Department of Administrative Services) – Relating to state financial administration; declaring an emergency.

**HB2089** Introduced and printed pursuant to House Rule 12.00. Pre-session filed (at the request of House Interim Committee on Revenue) – Relating to debt collection; prescribing an effective date.
