## HOUSE BILLS

**HB4020** Introduced and printed pursuant to House Rule 12.00. Pre-session filed (at the request of House Interim Committee on Higher Education, Innovation, and Workforce Development for Oregon Growth Board) – Relating to the Oregon Growth Board; declaring an emergency.

Provides that Oregon Growth Board, in accordance with rules adopted by board, may require that management company or state agency under contract with board invest certain amount in Oregon.

**HB4038** Introduced and printed pursuant to House Rule 12.00. Pre-session filed (at the request of House Interim Committee on Energy and Environment) – Relating to voting methods for cooperative corporations; declaring an emergency.

Permits shareholders in and members of cooperative corporations to vote by electronic means.

**HB4039** Introduced and printed pursuant to House Rule 12.00. Pre-session filed (at the request of House Interim Committee on Agriculture and Natural Resources) – Relating to aviation; declaring an emergency.

 2-1 First reading. Referred to Speaker's desk. Referred to Transportation and Economic Development with subsequent referral to Rural Communities, Land Use and Water. Public Hearing held.

Requires Oregon Board of Dentistry, upon request of individual who has been disciplined by board, to remove from its website and other publicly accessible print and electronic publications information related to disciplining individual if individual meets certain criteria.
