SB 1559 Allows qualifying off-premises sales licensee to obtain endorsement authorizing sale of distilled liquor at licensed premises.

SB 1549 Exempts persons authorized to engage in public accountancy in this state from provisions regulating investigators.
SB 1558 Authorizes Director of Department of Consumer and Business Services to pay compensation due to workers of members of certain decertified self-insured employer groups and to set standards by rule for proof of financial viability of self-insured employer and for insurance coverage retention and combined net worth of members of self-insured employer group.
SB 1502 Requires Department of Transportation to study development of uniform speed bump height and markings.
SB 1547 Authorizes county governing bodies and small business employers to enter into agreements for reimbursement of portion of wages paid to youth employees.
