## HOUSE BILLS

**HB2953** By COMMITTEE ON EDUCATION -- Relating to achievement compacts; declaring an emergency.

2-11(H) First reading. Referred to Speaker's desk.

Removes sunset on achievement compacts.

**HB2954** By Representative NEARMAN; Representatives BARRETO, MCLANE, PARRISH -- Relating to educational alternatives for children attending public schools who fail to achieve reading proficiency by the end of the third grade.

2-11(H) First reading. Referred to Speaker's desk.

Provides parents with alternative educational choices if student fails to achieve reading proficiency by end of third grade.

**HB2955** By Representatives WILLIAMSON, HOYLE, WHISNANT, ESQUIVEL, Senators EDWARDS, ROBLAN; Representatives BARTON, BENTZ, DAVIS, DOHERTY, FAGAN, GOMBERG, MCLAIN, OLSON, RAYFIELD, Senators BURDICK, DEVLIN, PROZANSKI, ROSENBAUM, STEINER HAYWARD - - Relating to Oregon Civics Day for Teachers; declaring an emergency.

2-11(H) First reading. Referred to Speaker's desk.

Directs Department of Education to administer process for providing funding for activities related to annual conference dedicated to Oregon civics and held on Oregon Civics Day for Teachers.

**HB2956** By Representatives KENY-GUYER, SMITH WARNER; Representatives BUCKLEY, FREDERICK, GORSEK, GREENLICK, LININGER, NOSSE, WITT, Senators DEMBROW, GELSER, RILEY -- Relating to state preemption of local authority to set minimum wage standards; declaring an emergency.

2-11(H) First reading. Referred to Speaker's desk.

Repeals state preemption of charter and statutory authority of local governments to set minimum wage requirements.

**HB2957** By COMMITTEE ON RULES -- Relating to local elections; declaring an emergency.

2-11(H) First reading. Referred to Speaker's desk.

Establishes specific dates for elections on county measures, city measures and district measures that are not referred to people by county governing body, city governing body or district elections authority.

**HB2958** By Representative BENTZ (at the request of Car and Truck Rental and Leasing Association) -- Relating to limited licenses to sell insurance in connection with vehicle rentals; declaring an emergency.

2-11(H) First reading. Referred to Speaker's desk.

Provides that limited license that rental company obtains to sell insurance in connection with renting vehicles also extends to rental company's employees and designated agents.

**HB2959** By Representatives WHISNANT, BUEHLER, Senator KNOPP -- Relating to use of fees charged by counties for certain housing programs.

2-11(H) First reading. Referred to Speaker's desk.

Requires Housing and Community Services Department to dedicate and use portion of moneys deposited in certain housing accounts from County Assessment and Taxation Fund for benefit of county from which fees deposited into fund were charged and collected.

**HB2960** By Representatives READ, WILLIAMSON, Senators BEYER, ROBLAN, ROSENBAUM -- Relating to retirement investments; declaring an emergency.

2-11(H) First reading. Referred to Speaker's desk.

Creates Oregon Retirement Savings Board in office of State Treasurer.

**HB2961** By Representatives BARTON, BUCKLEY -- Relating to state finance.

2-11(H) First reading. Referred to Speaker's desk.

Directs Legislative Assembly to appropriate amount equal to one percent of total amount of General Fund appropriations and lottery allocations for next biennium to both Oregon Rainy Day Fund and Education Stability Fund if state unemployment rate for previous year is six percent or less at time of last economic and revenue forecast of biennium.

**HB2962** By Representative BARTON -- Relating to the Trust for Cultural Development Account; declaring an emergency.

2-11(H) First reading. Referred to Speaker's desk.

Designates Trust for Cultural Development Account as trust account exclusively for arts and culture purposes.

**HB2963** By Representative BARTON -- Relating to probate law; declaring an emergency.

2-11(H) First reading. Referred to Speaker's desk.

Directs Oregon Law Commission to submit report to interim legislative committees, no later than July 1, 2016, regarding changes to existing statutory law that are recommended for purpose of streamlining and lowering cost of administration of probate estates in Oregon.

**HB2964** By Representative BARTON -- Relating to protected persons; declaring an emergency.

2-11(H) First reading. Referred to Speaker's desk.

Directs Oregon Law Commission to submit report to interim legislative committees, no later than July 1, 2016, regarding recommendations for compiling data and information regarding protected persons in Oregon who are subject to guardianship or conservatorship proceedings.

**HB2965** By Representative BARTON -- Relating to salaries for judges; declaring an emergency.

2-11(H) First reading. Referred to Speaker's desk.

Modifies annual salaries of judges of Supreme Court, Court of Appeals, Oregon Tax Court and circuit courts.

**HB2966** By Representative BARTON (at the request of Jonathan Schell, L.Ac.) -- Relating to acupuncture; declaring an emergency.

2-11(H) First reading. Referred to Speaker's desk.

Directs Oregon Medical Board to study regulation of and reimbursement for acupuncture services and report to Legislative Assembly on or before September 15, 2015.

**HB 2967** By Representatives WHISNANT, GALLEGOS, SPRENGER; Senator HASS – Relating to reports on State School Fund expenditures.

2-11(H) First reading. Referred to Speaker's desk.

Directs school districts to prepare and file annual reports related to students enrolled in English as second language program.

**HB 2968** By Representatives WHISNANT, GALLEGOS, SPRENGER; Senator HASS – Relating to reports on State School Fund expenditures.

2-11(H) First reading. Referred to Speaker's desk.

Directs school districts to prepare and file annual reports related to amounts received from State School Fund for students who are in poverty families.

**HB 2969** By Representatives POST, HOYLE, MCLANE; Representatives BARKER, BARRETO, BARTON, BENTZ, BUCKLEY, BUEHLER, DAVIS, DOHERTY, ESQUIVEL, FAGAN, HACK, HEARD, HUFFMAN, JOHNSON, KENNEMER, KRIEGER, NEARMAN, OLSON, RAYFIELD, SMITH, STARK, WEIDNER, WHISNANT, WILSON, WITT, Senators FERRIOLI, JOHNSON, KNOPP, KRUSE – Relating to activities permitted at certified smoke shops; declaring an emergency.

2-11(H) First reading. Referred to Speaker's desk.

Allows on-premises consumption of food and nonalcoholic beverages at certified smoke shops.

**HB 2970** By Representative BARTON – Relating to cultural programs.

2-11(H) First reading. Referred to Speaker's desk.

Transfers Oregon Arts Commission from Oregon Business Development Department to Office of the Secretary of State.

**HB 2971** By Representative GORSEK – Relating to transportation.

2-11(H) First reading. Referred to Speaker's desk.

Requires Department of Transportation to study feasibility of undertaking transportation project on Hayden Island.

**HB 2972** By Representatives HAYDEN, KENY-GUYER, PARRISH; Representatives BUEHLER, LIVELY, PILUSO – Relating to dental screenings of students; declaring an emergency.

2-11(H) First reading. Referred to Speaker's desk.

Requires public school students seven years of age or younger who are beginning educational program to have dental screening.

**HB 2973** By Representative WHISNANT – Relating to degree programs at public universities; declaring an emergency.

2-11(H) First reading. Referred to Speaker's desk.

Establishes Affordable Baccalaureate Degree Act.

**HB 2974** By Representatives LININGER, MCLAIN; Representative JOHNSON – Relating to reapportionment.

2-11(H) First reading. Referred to Speaker's desk.

Requires Legislative Assembly or Secretary of State to hold public hearings throughout state prior to adopting congressional or legislative reapportionment plan.

**HB 2975** By Representatives WHISNANT, GOMBERG; Representative BUEHLER – Relating to state agency fees; declaring an emergency.

2-11(H) First reading. Referred to Speaker's desk.

Specifies that new or increased fees adopted by state agency do not become effective unless approved by Legislative Assembly by law.

**HB 2976** By Representative WHISNANT – Relating to public contracts involving former employee of contracting agency.

2-11(H) First reading. Referred to Speaker's desk.

Prohibits employee who separates from contracting agency, for two years after date of employee's separation, from becoming, or seeking employment with, contractor with which contracting agency enters or has entered into public contract.

#### HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTIONS

---

**HJR 24** By COMMITTEE ON RULES – Proposing amendment to Oregon Constitution relating to bills for raising revenue.

2-11(H) First reading. Referred to Speaker's desk.

Proposes amendment to Oregon Constitution to allow bills that raise revenue and that have sole effect of reversing policy that, at enactment, required only simple majority of all members elected to each house, to pass with simple majority of both houses.

**SB 76** Printed pursuant to Senate Interim Rule 213.28 by order of the President of the Senate in conformance with presession filing rules, indicating neither advocacy nor opposition on the part of the President. (at the request of Secretary of State Kate Brown) – Relating to filings with the Secretary of State; declaring an emergency.

1-12(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

1-20 Referred to Business and Transportation.

2-2 Public Hearing and Work Session held.

2-5 Recommendation: Do pass.

Second reading.

2-10 Third reading. Carried by Thomsen. Passed.

Ayes, 29; nays, 1--Boquist.

2-11(H) First reading. Referred to Speaker's desk.

Removes requirement for business to file notice of intent to conduct going out of business sale with Secretary of State but requires business to display notice of intent at location where going out of business sale will occur.

**SB 77** Printed pursuant to Senate Interim Rule 213.28 by order of the President of the Senate in conformance with presession filing rules, indicating neither advocacy nor opposition on the part of the President. (at the request of Secretary of State Kate Brown) – Relating to formations of corporations sole; declaring an emergency.

1-12(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

1-20 Referred to Business and Transportation.

2-2 Public Hearing and Work Session held.

2-5 Recommendation: Do pass.

Second reading.

2-10 Third reading. Carried by Monroe. Passed.

Ayes, 18; nays, 12--Baertschiger Jr, Boquist, Ferrioli, Girod, Hansell, Knopp, Kruse, Olsen, Thatcher, Thomsen, Whitsett, Winters.

2-11(H) First reading. Referred to Speaker's desk.

This measure has minimal fiscal impact, no statement issued.

Provides that corporation sole may not be formed or incorporated in this state on or after effective date of Act.

**SB 140** Printed pursuant to Senate Interim Rule 213.28 by order of the President of the Senate in conformance with pre-session filing rules, indicating neither advocacy nor opposition on the part of the President. (at the request of Senate Interim Committee on Business and Transportation for Oregon Broadband Advisory Council) – Relating to broadband transmissions.

 2-5 Recommendation: Do pass.

 Extends sunset date for Oregon Broadband Advisory Council.

**SB 281** Printed pursuant to Senate Interim Rule 213.28 by order of the President of the Senate in conformance with pre-session filing rules, indicating neither advocacy nor opposition on the part of the President. (at the request of Governor John A. Kitzhaber, M.D., for Oregon Board of Naturopathic Medicine) – Relating to naturopathy.

 2-5 Recommendation: Do pass.

Changes term of office provisions for member of Oregon Board of Naturopathic Medicine.

**SB 302** By Senator GIROD (Pre-session filed.) – Relating to prescription drugs used for purposes related to dentistry; declaring an emergency.

 2-5 Recommendation: Do pass.

 2-11(H) First reading. Referred to Speaker's desk.

Clarifies that practice of dentistry includes prescribing, dispensing and administering prescription drugs for purposes related to dentistry.

**SB 456** By Senator BEYER (Pre-session filed.) – Relating to the voluntary emission reduction program for natural gas utilities; declaring an emergency.

 1-20 Referred to Business and Transportation.  
 2-2 Public Hearing and Work Session held.  
 2-5 Recommendation: Do pass.  
 Second reading.  
 2-10 Third reading. Carried by Beyer. Passed.  
 Ayes, 29; nays, 1--Thatcher.  
 2-11(H) First reading. Referred to Speaker's desk.

Clarifies that natural gas utility may receive additional incentives for projects approved by Public Utility Commission under voluntary emission reduction program.

**SB 482** By Senators EDWARDS, THOMSEN, HASS, RILEY, Representative HOYLE; Senators DEVLIN, GELSER, KNOPP, MONNES ANDERSON, ROSENBAUM, STEINER HAYWARD,

Representatives CLEM, OLSON (Pre-session filed.) – Relating to partnerships for manufacturing economic development.

- 1-12(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.  
 1-20 Referred to Business and Transportation.  
 2-2 Public Hearing and Work Session held.  
 2-5 Recommendation: Do pass.  
 Second reading.  
 2-10 Third reading. Carried by Edwards, Thomsen. Passed.  
 Ayes, 30.  
 2-11(H) First reading. Referred to Speaker's desk.

This measure has minimal fiscal impact, no statement issued.

Authorizes Oregon Business Development Department to appoint Pacific Northwest Manufacturing Partnership Advisory Committee to advise department regarding Pacific Northwest Manufacturing Partnership and manufacturing economic development in geographic regions located within Willamette Valley and Columbia River corridor.
