HOUSE BILLS

HB 3485 By Representative STARK; Representatives ESQUIVEL, LININGER, NEARMAN, PILUSO, POST, SMITH, WEIDNER, WILSON – Relating to Oregon Liquor Control Commission revenue distribution recipients.

3-10(H) First reading. Referred to Speaker's desk.

Directs Legislative Fiscal Office to conduct study and report findings regarding Oregon Liquor Control Commission revenue distribution recipients.

Permits insurer, under specified conditions, to post insurance policy and endorsements on insurer's website in lieu of mailing or delivering insurance policy and endorsements to insured.
