## HOUSE BILLS

**HB 3492** By Representative HUFFMAN; Representatives BENTZ, HELM, READ, REARDON, Senator ROBLAN – Relating to taxation of solar projects; prescribing an effective date.

3-16(H) First reading. Referred to Speaker's desk.

Requires county, upon request of owner of solar project, to enter into agreement, for period not to exceed 20 years, pursuant to which property constituting solar project is exempt from property taxation and owner pays fee in lieu of taxes.

**HB 3493** By Representative LININGER -- Relating to calculations for the State School Fund; declaring an emergency.

3-16(H) First reading. Referred to Speaker's desk.

Provides that Superintendent of Public Instruction and State Board of Education may not make or authorize certain calculations related to aggregate days membership and weighted average daily membership except as specified by statute.

**HB 3494** By Representative BARTON; Representatives BUEHLER, GOMBERG – Relating to animals.

3-16(H) First reading. Referred to Speaker's desk.

Prohibits landlord from requiring applicant or tenant to declare or devocalize animal otherwise allowed on premises or to advertise in manner that discourages application from potential applicant with otherwise allowed animal that has not been declawed or devocalized.

**HB 3495** By Representative GOMBERG (at the request of Association of Oregon Counties) -- Relating to contributions to the Oregon Public Service Retirement Plan.

3-16(H) First reading. Referred to Speaker's desk.

Provides for employer and employee contributions to pension program and individual account program of Oregon Public Service Retirement Plan to first be made for new members for wages that are attributable to services performed during first full pay period following six-month probationary period, without regard to when wages are considered earned for other purposes.

## SENATE BILLS

**SB 146** Printed pursuant to Senate Interim Rule 213.28 by order of the President of the Senate in conformance with pre-session filing rules, indicating neither advocacy nor opposition on the part of the President. (at the request of Senate Interim Committee on Health Care and Human Services) -- Relating to small employers.

**SB 381** Printed pursuant to Senate Interim Rule 213.28 by order of the President of the Senate in conformance with pre-session filing rules, indicating neither advocacy nor opposition on the part of the President. (at the request of Senate Interim Committee on Judiciary for Board of Governors of the Oregon State Bar) -- Relating to the Oregon State Bar; declaring an emergency.

1-20 Referred to Judiciary.

Recommendation: Do pass with amendments. (Printed A-Eng.)

Directs Board of Governors of Oregon State Bar to establish position on board for active member of bar who maintains principal office outside State of Oregon.

**SB 505** By Senators MONNES ANDERSON, BATES -- Relating to the influenza virus.

2-2(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

2-3 Referred to Health Care.

3-2 Public Hearing held.

3-9 Work Session held.

3-11 Recommendation: Do pass.

Second reading.

3-12 Third reading. Carried by Monnes Anderson. Passed.

3-16(H) First reading. Referred to Speaker's desk.

Requires, from October 1 through March 1 of each year, each hospital in this state to make offer to each patient of hospital who is 65 years of age or older to immunize patient against influenza virus.
