## HOUSE BILLS

**HB3496** By Representative BARTON (at the request of North Clackamas School District) – Relating to approved transportation costs; declaring an emergency.

3-17(H) First reading. Referred to Speaker's desk.

Considers costs incurred in providing transportation to students of summer sessions of classes provided by school district to be approved transportation costs for purpose of State School Fund distributions.

**HB3497** By Representative HUFFMAN – Relating to funding for education service districts; declaring an emergency.

3-17(H) First reading. Referred to Speaker's desk.

Modifies method by which minimum amount distributed to education service districts is calculated.

**SB 85** Printed pursuant to Senate Interim Rule 213.28 by order of the President of the Senate in conformance with pre-session filing rules, indicating neither advocacy nor opposition on the part of the President. (at the request of Senate Interim Committee on Veterans and Emergency Preparedness) – Relating to financing improvements for seismic rehabilitation; declaring an emergency.

3-12 Recommendation: Do pass.

3-17(H) First reading. Referred to Speaker's desk.

Authorizes local governments to implement programs to make loans or facilitate private financing of seismic rehabilitation of multifamily residential dwellings or commercial or industrial buildings by property owners.
