HOUSE BILLS

HB3498 By Representative **ESQUIVEL** -- Relating to certification for outdoor recreational activities; declaring an emergency.

3-18(H) First reading. Referred to Speaker's desk.

Provides that applicant for registration by State Marine Board as outfitter and guide may not have been convicted of certain offenses preceding application.

HB3499 By Representatives **GALLEGOS, KOMP, Senator ROBLAN; Representatives HUFFMAN, VEGA PEDERSON, WHISNANT** -- Relating to English language learner programs; declaring an emergency.

3-18(H) First reading. Referred to Speaker's desk.

Directs Department of Education to convene advisory group related to English language learner programs.

SENATE BILLS

SB 225 Printed pursuant to Senate Interim Rule 213.28 by order of the President of the Senate in conformance with pre-session filing rules, indicating neither advocacy nor opposition on the part of the President. (at the request of Governor John A. Kitzhaber, M.D., for Department of Human Services) -- Relating to mass changes in supplemental nutrition assistance program; declaring an emergency.

1-20 Referred to Human Services and Early Childhood.

3-12 Recommendation: Do pass with amendments. (Printed A-Eng.)

3-18(H) First reading. Referred to Speaker's desk.

This measure has a fiscal impact statement.

Removes requirement for agency to send individual notice to each affected recipient of supplemental nutrition assistance or Women, Infants and Children Program when suspension or closure of grant of assistance is caused by change in benefit or standard by federal government and change affects all or significant portion of recipients.

SB 628 By Senator **HANSELL, Representative BARRETO** -- Relating to U.S. Highway 395.

2-12(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

Referred to Business and Transportation.

3-11 Public Hearing and Work Session held.

3-16 Recommendation: Do pass.

Second reading.

3-17 Third reading. Carried by Hansell. Passed.

Ayes, 30.

3-18(H) First reading. Referred to Speaker's desk.

This measure has minimal fiscal impact, no statement issued.

Designates portion of U.S. Highway 395, known as Pendleton-John Day Highway, as Don Kendall Memorial Highway.

SB 686 By COMMITTEE ON WORKFORCE -- Relating to eligibility under federal workforce development law.

2-19(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

2-20 Referred to Workforce.

3-2 Public Hearing held.

3-11 Work Session held.

3-12 Recommendation: Do pass with amendments. (Printed A-Eng.)

3-16 Second reading.

3-17 Third reading. Carried by Dembrow. Passed.

3-18(H) First reading. Referred to Speaker's desk.

Provides that individual enrolled in alternative education program may be considered out-of-school youth for purposes of Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act.
