HOUSE BILLS

HB 3505 By Representatives PARRISH, BUEHLER, HACK; Representative DAVIS – Relating to public records; declaring an emergency.

3-26(H) First reading. Referred to Speaker's desk.

Requires public bodies to establish public records retention schedules that require minimum three-year retention of public records.

HB 3506 By Representative KENY-GUYER, Senators BATES, GIROD; Representatives HOYLE, KENNEMER, WEIDNER, Senators KNOPP, ROBLAN – Relating to medical assistance.

3-26(H) First reading. Referred to Speaker's desk.

Prohibits certain restrictions on medical assistance coverage of dentures, partial dentures and tooth extractions.

SENATE BILLS

SB 135 By Senator DEVLIN, Representative BUCKLEY (Pre-session filed.) – Relating to payment of educational costs of children in treatment programs; declaring an emergency.

1-12(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

1-20 Referred to Education.

3-5 Public Hearing held.

3-17 Work Session held.

3-23 Recommendation: Do pass with amendments. (Printed A-Eng.)

3-24 Second reading.

3-25 Third reading. Carried by Gelser. Passed.

3-26(H) First reading. Referred to Speaker's desk.

This measure has minimal fiscal impact, no statement issued.

Directs Department of Education to pay for costs of education of students in eligible day treatment programs and eligible residential treatment programs by making grants in aid to school districts where programs are located.

SB 927 By Senators MONROE, HANSELL – Relating to authority of metropolitan service district to finance visitor-oriented facilities; declaring an emergency.

3-16(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

Referred to Finance and Revenue.

3-23 Public Hearing and Work Session held.

3-24 Recommendation: Do pass.

Second reading.

3-25 Third reading. Carried by Riley. Passed.
