HB3512 By Representatives JOHNSON, BUEHLER --
Relating to skiing; declaring an emergency.

Revises provisions relating to liability arising out of skiing.

HB3513 By Representative HAYDEN; Representatives

to health care.

Creates Rural Medicaid Access and Development Act to provide financial support to rural hospitals and health care providers and to establish primary care residency programs.
