## HOUSE BILLS

**HB 3543** By Representative KENNEMER (at the request of Boring Community Planning Organization) – Relating to metropolitan service districts.

4-14(H) First reading. Referred to Speaker's desk.

Permits electors of areas within urban growth boundary, urban reserve, rural reserve or metropolitan service district to petition county board for withdrawal.

**SB 145** Printed pursuant to Senate Interim Rule 213.28 by order of the President of the Senate in conformance with pre-session filing rules, indicating neither advocacy nor opposition on the part of the President. (at the request of Senate Interim Committee on Health Care and Human Services) – Relating to the definition of "small employer"

(at the request of Senate Interim Committee on Judiciary) – Relating to fees in criminal cases.

Prohibits prosecuting attorney from charging fee for performing requirements associated with motion for setting aside conviction.

**SB 588** By Senator ROBLAN – Relating to the legal status of public charter schools; declaring an emergency.

2-5(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

2-9 Referred to Education.

4-9 Recommendation: Do pass.

Second reading.

4-13 Third reading. Carried by Roblan. Passed.

This measure has minimal fiscal impact, no statement issued.

Allows school district and public charter school to be considered single legal entity for purpose of public charter school law if public charter school is only school in school district and other conditions are met.

**SB 921** By Senators HANSELL, COURTNEY, Representative KOTEK; Senators DEVLIN, KRUSE, THOMSEN, Representative PARRISH – Relating to interstate highway median barriers.

3-9(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

3-11 Referred to Business and Transportation.

4-6 Public Hearing and Work Session held.

4-9 Recommendation: Do pass.

Second reading.

4-13 Third reading. Carried by Monroe. Passed.

Thatcher declared potential conflict of interest.

4-14(H) First reading. Referred to Speaker's desk.

Directs Department of Transportation to make efforts to complete installation of median barriers between opposing lanes of travel on interstate highways in certain circumstances.
