HOUSE BILLS

HB 3545 By Representatives PARRISH, WEIDNER; Representatives ESQUIVEL, EVANS, HUFFMAN, KRIEGER, LIVELY, NOSSE, PILUSO, POST, WHISNANT, WILSON -- Relating to the registration of electors; declaring an emergency.

Requires every state agency, county and district to make available to Secretary of State information required for voter registration contained in any database in possession of agency, county or district.
