HOUSE BILLS

HB3550 By Representatives HACK, BARRETO, BOONE; Representatives CLEM, ESQUIVEL, HAYDEN, HEARD, KRIEGER, MCKEOWN, OLSON, POST, WEIDNER -- Relating to volunteer firefighters; prescribing an effective date.

5-5(H) First reading. Referred to Speaker's desk.

Authorizes county to grant exemption from property taxes imposed on homesteads of volunteer firefighters.

SENATE BILLS

SB 9 By Senators COURTNEY, FERRIOLI, ROSENBAUM, Representatives KOTEK, HOYLE; Senators DEVLIN, JOHNSON, MONNES ANDERSON (at the request of Governor Kate Brown) -- Relating to public records; declaring an emergency.

4-6(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

4-7 Referred to Rules.

4-28 Public Hearing and Work Session held.

4-30 Recommendation: Do pass.

5-4 Third reading. Carried by Rosenbaum. Passed.

Directs Secretary of State to conduct performance audit of state agency public records retention and disclosure practices, including analysis and recommendations on specified criteria.

SB 341 Printed pursuant to Senate Interim Rule 213.28 by order of the President of the Senate in conformance with presession filing rules, indicating neither advocacy nor opposition on the part of the President. (at the request of Senate Interim Committee on Judiciary) -- Relating to agri-tourism; declaring an emergency.

Provides that agri-tourism professional is not liable for injury to or death of participant arising out of inherent risks of agri-tourism if agri-tourism professional posts certain notices.
