HB 3551 By Representatives WHITSETT, KOTEK – Relating to requirements for vehicle repair shops.

5-6(H) First reading. Referred to Speaker's desk.

Requires vehicle repair shop to display sign that advises customer of certain rights.

HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTIONS

HCR 30 By Representative HUFFMAN, Senator BOQUIST; Representatives BOONE, BUEHLER, EVANS, LIVELY, MCLANE, PARRISH, PILUSO, WHISNANT, WHITSETT, Senators FERRIOLI, KNOPP – Designating Oregon as Purple Heart State.

(at the request of Senate Interim Committee on Judiciary) – Relating to driving while under influence of intoxicants.
