HOUSE BILLS

HB 3559 By Representative WILSON – Relating to seaweed.

6-4(H) First reading. Referred to Speaker's desk.

Requires State Parks and Recreation Department to adopt permit program by rule for small-scale commercial hand harvesting of kelp or other seaweed from ocean shore and tidal submerged lands.

HB 3560 By Representative SPRENGER – Relating to school mascots; declaring an emergency.

6-4(H) First reading. Referred to Speaker's desk.

Prohibits use of Native American mascot by public school unless certain conditions met.

SENATE BILLS

SB 966 By COMMITTEE ON RULES – Relating to training programs for public officials; declaring an emergency.

5-21(S) Introduction and first reading. Referred to President's desk.

5-22 Referred to Rules.

5-28 Public Hearing and Work Session held.
