HOUSE BILLS

HB 3562 By Representative BUEHLER – Relating to public employee whistleblowers; declaring an emergency.

6-10(H) First reading. Referred to Speaker's desk.

Prohibits retaliation against public employees for disclosing public records or other information related to unlawful conduct.

HB 3563 By Representative SMITH, Senator JOHNSON; Representatives HOYLE, MCLANE, WITT, Senator BEYER – Relating to requirements for engaging in surface mining.

6-10(H) First reading. Referred to Speaker's desk.

Requires person that engages in surface mining activities at levels below thresholds for applicability of operating permit and reclamation requirements to obtain exclusion certificate from State Department of Geology and Mineral Industries and to pay fee.

SB 832 By Senators MONNES ANDERSON, WINTERS, BATES; Senators GELSER, KNOPP, STEINER HAYWARD, Representatives BUEHLER, KENNEMER, WHISNANT – Relating to integrated health care; declaring an emergency.

This measure has minimal fiscal impact, no statement issued.

Requires Oregon Health Authority to prescribe by rule standards for integrating behavioral health services and physical health services in patient centered primary care homes and behavioral health homes.
