1-27(H) Pre-session Released to the Public.  
2-1 First reading. Referred to Speaker's desk.  
Public Hearing scheduled.

Modifies conditions under which landlord may terminate month-to-month tenancy after first year of occupancy.

**HB4002** By Representative GALLEGOS (Pre-session filed.) – Relating to chronic absences; declaring an emergency.

1-27(H) Pre-session Released to the Public.  
2-1 First reading. Referred to Speaker's desk.  
2-3 Public Hearing and Possible Work Session scheduled.

Directs Department of Education to develop and implement statewide education plan to address chronic absences of students in public schools.

**HB4003** By Representatives KOTEK, WILLIAMSON, GALLEGOS (Pre-session filed.) – Relating to law enforcement; declaring an emergency.

1-27(H) Pre-session Released to the Public.  
2-1 First reading. Referred to Speaker's desk.  
2-2 Public Hearing and Work Session scheduled.

Extends sunset of Law Enforcement Profiling Work Group to July 1, 2017.

**HB4006** By Representative NATHANSON (Pre-session filed.) – Relating to economic development; declaring an emergency.

1-27(H) Pre-session Released to the Public.  
2-1 First reading. Referred to Speaker's desk.

Establishes Task Force on Economic Development.

**HB4007** By Representative SMITH (Pre-session filed.) – Relating to rangeland protection associations; declaring an emergency.

1-27(H) Pre-session Released to the Public.  
2-1 First reading. Referred to Speaker's desk.

Makes certain governmental entities rangeland protection associations.

**HB4008** By Representative SMITH (Pre-session filed.) – Relating to the Oregon State Lottery Commission; declaring an emergency.

1-27(H) Pre-session Released to the Public.  
2-1 First reading. Referred to Speaker's desk.  
Public Hearing scheduled.

Authorizes Oregon State Lottery Commission to administer raffles on behalf of specific Oregon nonprofit organization in exchange for payment.

**HB4009** By Representatives CLEM, GILLIAM (Pre-session filed.) – Relating to a day to honor Minoru Yasui; declaring an emergency.

1-27(H) Pre-session Released to the Public.  
2-1 First reading. Referred to Speaker's desk.  
Public Hearing and Possible Work Session scheduled.

Designates March 28 of each year as Minoru Yasui Day.

**HB4010** By Representatives WHISNANT, NEARMAN (Pre-session filed.) – Relating to state programs at public universities.

1-27(H) Pre-session Released to the Public.  
2-1 First reading. Referred to Speaker's desk.

Requires each public university to report to Legislative Assembly detailed list of all university expenditures on state programs.

**HB4011** Introduced and printed pursuant to House Rule 12.00. Pre-session filed (at the request of House Interim Committee on Rural Communities, Land Use and Water) – Relating to members of the Public Employees Retirement System employed by the Oregon State Hospital; declaring an emergency.

1-27(H) Pre-session Released to the Public.  
2-1 First reading. Referred to Speaker's desk.  
Public Hearing scheduled.

Provides that employees of Oregon State Hospital qualify as police officers under Public Employees Retirement System.

**HB4012** Introduced and printed pursuant to House Rule 12.00. Pre-session filed (at the request of House Interim Committee on Rural Communities, Land Use and Water) – Relating to water; declaring an emergency.

1-27(H) Pre-session Released to the Public.  
2-1 First reading. Referred to Speaker's desk.  
2-3 Public Hearing scheduled.

Authorizes issuance of lottery bonds to finance water storage and distribution projects.

**HB4013** Introduced and printed pursuant to House Rule 12.00. Pre-session filed (at the request of House Interim Committee on Rural Communities, Land Use and Water) – Relating to vulnerable person fatality review teams.

1-27(H) Pre-session Released to the Public.  
2-1 First reading. Referred to Speaker's desk.  
2-9 Public Hearing and Possible Work Session scheduled.

Authorizes county governing body to establish multidisciplinary elderly or vulnerable person fatality review team to assist local organizations and agencies in identifying and reviewing fatalities involving abuse or neglect of elderly or vulnerable persons.

**HB4014** Introduced and printed pursuant to House Rule 12.00. Pre-session filed (at the request of Joint Interim Committee on Marijuana Legislation) – Relating to cannabis; declaring an emergency.

1-27(H) Pre-session Released to the Public.  
2-1 First reading. Referred to Speaker's desk.  
2-2 Public Hearing scheduled.

Makes changes to laws regulating production, processing, sale, use and governance of cannabis.

**HB4015** Introduced and printed pursuant to House Rule 12.00. Pre-session filed (at the request of House Interim Committee on Health Care) – Relating to vision care insurance.

1-27(H) Pre-session Released to the Public.

2-1 First reading. Referred to Speaker's desk.  
Public Hearing and Possible Work Session scheduled.

Allows vision care insurer to restrict or limit vision care provider's choice of supplier for covered services and allows insurer to require vision care provider to participate in one vision care insurance plan or discount card program.

**HB4016** Introduced and printed pursuant to House Rule 12.00. Pre-session filed (at the request of House Interim Committee on Health Care) -- Relating to impaired health professional programs; declaring an emergency.

1-27(H) Pre-session Released to the Public.  
2-1 First reading. Referred to Speaker's desk.  
Public Hearing and Possible Work Session scheduled.

Permits Oregon Board of Dentistry, Oregon Medical Board, Oregon State Board of Nursing and State Board of Pharmacy to contract to establish impaired health professional program for licensees of boards.

**HB4017** Introduced and printed pursuant to House Rule 12.00. Pre-session filed (at the request of House Interim Committee on Health Care) -- Relating to health care; declaring an emergency.

1-27(H) Pre-session Released to the Public.  
2-1 First reading. Referred to Speaker's desk.

Requires Department of Consumer and Business Services in collaboration with Oregon Health Authority and stakeholder advisory group to create blueprint for Basic Health Program.

**HB4018** By Representative ESQUIVEL (Pre-session filed.) -- Relating to annexation of industrial land; declaring an emergency.

1-27(H) Pre-session Released to the Public.  
2-1 First reading. Referred to Speaker's desk.

Extends sunset on provisions that prohibit annexation of specified land without written consent of owner of land.

**HB4019** Introduced and printed pursuant to House Rule 12.00. Pre-session filed (at the request of House Interim Committee on Higher Education, Innovation, and Workforce Development for Higher Education Coordinating Commission) -- Relating to higher education.

1-27(H) Pre-session Released to the Public.  
2-1 First reading. Referred to Speaker's desk.  
Public Hearing and Possible Work Session scheduled.

Clarifies duties of Executive Director of the Office of Student Access and Completion.

**HB4020** Introduced and printed pursuant to House Rule 12.00. Pre-session filed (at the request of House Interim Committee on Higher Education, Innovation, and Workforce Development for Oregon Growth Board) -- Relating to the Oregon Growth Board.

1-27(H) Pre-session Released to the Public.  
2-1 First reading. Referred to Speaker's desk.  
Public Hearing scheduled.  
2-3 Work Session scheduled.

Provides that Oregon Growth Board, in accordance with rules adopted by board, may require that management company or state agency under contract with board invest certain amount in Oregon.

**HB4021** Introduced and printed pursuant to House Rule 12.00. Pre-session filed (at the request of House Interim Committee on Higher Education, Innovation, and Workforce Development) -- Relating to student loans; declaring an emergency.

1-27(H) Pre-session Released to the Public.  
2-1 First reading. Referred to Speaker's desk.

2-3 Public Hearing and Possible Work Session scheduled.

Requires State Treasurer to conduct study to assess viability of establishing student loan refinancing program within office of State Treasurer.

**HB4022** Introduced and printed pursuant to House Rule 12.00. Pre-session filed (at the request of House Interim Committee on Education) -- Relating to reemployment of members of Public Employees Retirement System in the field of speech-language pathology; declaring an emergency.

1-27(H) Pre-session Released to the Public.  
2-1 First reading. Referred to Speaker's desk.  
Public Hearing and Possible Work Session scheduled.

Exempts retired member of Public Employees Retirement System from limitations on reemployment by public employer if member is reemployed by school district or education service district to provide services as speech-language pathologist or speech-language pathology assistant.

**HB4023** Introduced and printed pursuant to House Rule 12.00. Pre-session filed (at the request of House Interim Committee on Education) -- Relating to residency for school purposes after district boundary changes; prescribing an effective date.

1-27(H) Pre-session Released to the Public.  
2-1 First reading. Referred to Speaker's desk.  
Public Hearing and Possible Work Session scheduled.

Considers certain individuals to be residents of school district in which individuals attend school even if legal residences of individuals are no longer within district because of district boundary change.

**HB4024** Introduced and printed pursuant to House Rule 12.00. Pre-session filed (at the request of House Interim Committee on Education) -- Relating to procedures related to hostile education environments; prescribing an effective date.

1-27(H) Pre-session Released to the Public.  
2-1 First reading. Referred to Speaker's desk.

Directs State Board of Education to adopt by rule complaint process to report district policy in violation of state law prohibiting harassment, intimidation, bullying and cyberbullying.

**HB4025** Introduced and printed pursuant to House Rule 12.00. Pre-session filed (at the request of House Interim Committee on Revenue) -- Relating to connection to federal tax law; prescribing an effective date.

1-27(H) Pre-session Released to the Public.  
2-1 First reading. Referred to Speaker's desk.  
2-3 Public Hearing scheduled.  
2-4 Public Hearing and Work Session scheduled.

Updates connection date to federal Internal Revenue Code and other provisions of federal tax law.

**HB4026** Introduced and printed pursuant to House Rule 12.00. Pre-session filed (at the request of House Interim Committee on Revenue) -- Relating to taxation; prescribing an effective date; providing for revenue raising that requires approval by a three-fifths majority.

1-27(H) Pre-session Released to the Public.  
2-1 First reading. Referred to Speaker's desk.  
2-5 Public Hearing scheduled.

Phases out role of Oregon Liquor Control Commission in purchasing, importing, warehousing and retailing of distilled liquors.

**HB4027** Introduced and printed pursuant to House Rule 12.00. Pre-session filed (at the request of House Interim Committee on Revenue) -- Relating to tax expenditures; prescribing an effective date.

1-27(H) Pre-session Released to the Public.  
2-1 First reading. Referred to Speaker's desk.  
Public Hearing scheduled.

Directs Legislative Revenue Officer to submit report addressing selected tax expenditures to Legislative Assembly and to make recommendations for systematic review and sunset of certain tax expenditures.

**HB4028** Introduced and printed pursuant to House Rule 12.00. Pre-session filed (at the request of House Interim Committee on Rules) – Relating to firearm transfers; declaring an emergency.

1-27(H) Pre-session Released to the Public.  
2-1 First reading. Referred to Speaker's desk.

Extends exemption from private firearm criminal background check requirement when firearm is provided to transferee preparing to engage in or in process of completing activities related to hunting, trapping or target shooting.

**HB4029** By Representative PARRISH; Senator JOHNSON (Pre-session filed.) – Relating to public employee benefits.

1-27(H) Pre-session Released to the Public.  
2-1 First reading. Referred to Speaker's desk.

Modifies funding mechanism for public employees' health care benefit to avoid excise tax under Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act.

**HB4030** By Representatives DOHERTY, BUCKLEY, WHISNANT; Representatives MCLAIN, NATHANSON, Senators DEVLIN, STEINER HAYWARD (at the request of Tualatin Valley Fire and Rescue) (Pre-session filed.) – Relating to medical assistance reimbursement of emergency medical services; declaring an emergency.

1-27(H) Pre-session Released to the Public.  
2-1 First reading. Referred to Speaker's desk.  
Public Hearing and Possible Work Session scheduled.

Requires Oregon Health Authority to amend Medicaid state plan to implement programs to increase medical assistance reimbursement paid to public providers of emergency medical services.

**HB4031** By Representative DOHERTY, Senator MONROE; Representatives GALLEGOS, GOMBERG, GORSEK, KOMP, RAYFIELD, SMITH WARNER, WILLIAMSON (at the request of Oregon Alliance of Children's Programs) (Pre-session filed.) – Relating to school absenteeism; declaring an emergency.

1-27(H) Pre-session Released to the Public.  
2-1 First reading. Referred to Speaker's desk.  
2-3 Public Hearing and Possible Work Session scheduled.

Directs Chief Education Office to design and implement pilot program to decrease rates of school absenteeism.

**HB4032** By Representative KENNEMER (Pre-session filed.) – Relating to Bureau of Labor and Industries publications.

1-27(H) Pre-session Released to the Public.  
2-1 First reading. Referred to Speaker's desk.  
Public Hearing scheduled.

Requires Commissioner of Bureau of Labor and Industries to make available, in electronic format, bureau publications free of charge to Oregon employers.

**HB4033** By Representative FREDERICK (Pre-session filed.) - - Relating to cultural awareness of educators; declaring an emergency.

1-27(H) Pre-session Released to the Public.  
2-1 First reading. Referred to Speaker's desk.  
2-5 Public Hearing and Possible Work Session scheduled.

Specifies that moneys may be distributed under Network of Quality Teaching and Learning for purposes of advancing Educators Equity Act, improving cultural competence of educators and ensuring educators are trained in culturally relevant educational practices.

**HB4034** By Representative HELM (Pre-session filed.) – Relating to black carbon.

1-27(H) Pre-session Released to the Public.  
2-1 First reading. Referred to Speaker's desk.

Makes policy findings regarding black carbon that results from unplanned forest and rangeland fires.

**HB4035** By Representative SMITH WARNER (Pre-session filed.) – Relating to information about corporate taxpayers; prescribing an effective date.

1-27(H) Pre-session Released to the Public.  
2-1 First reading. Referred to Speaker's desk.

Requires Department of Revenue to submit to Legislative Revenue Officer information from Oregon tax returns about certain corporations doing business in Oregon.

**HB4036** Introduced and printed pursuant to House Rule 12.00. Pre-session filed (at the request of House Interim Committee on Energy and Environment) – Relating to utility regulation; declaring an emergency.

1-27(H) Pre-session Released to the Public.  
2-1 First reading. Referred to Speaker's desk.  
2-2 Public Hearing scheduled.  
2-4 Public Hearing and Possible Work Session scheduled.

Requires each electric company providing electricity to retail electricity consumers located in this state to eliminate coal-fired resources from electric company's electricity supply.

**HB4037** Introduced and printed pursuant to House Rule 12.00. Pre-session filed (at the request of House Interim Committee on Energy and Environment) – Relating to solar energy; declaring an emergency.

1-27(H) Pre-session Released to the Public.  
2-1 First reading. Referred to Speaker's desk.  
2-2 Public Hearing scheduled.  
2-4 Public Hearing and Possible Work Session scheduled.

Directs Oregon Business Development Department to establish program to incentivize generation of electricity derived from solar energy.

**HB4038** Introduced and printed pursuant to House Rule 12.00. Pre-session filed (at the request of House Interim Committee on Energy and Environment) – Relating to voting methods for cooperative corporations; declaring an emergency.

1-27(H) Pre-session Released to the Public.  
2-1 First reading. Referred to Speaker's desk.  
2-3 Public Hearing and Work Session scheduled.

Permits shareholders in and members of cooperative corporations to vote by electronic means.

**HB4039** Introduced and printed pursuant to House Rule 12.00. Pre-session filed (at the request of House Interim Committee on Agriculture and Natural Resources) – Relating to aviation; declaring an emergency.

1-27(H) Pre-session Released to the Public.  
2-1 First reading. Referred to Speaker's desk.  
Public Hearing scheduled.  
2-3 Work Session scheduled.

Modifies definition of "rural airport" for purposes of through the fence operations pilot program.

**HB4040** Introduced and printed pursuant to House Rule 12.00. Pre-session filed (at the request of House Interim Committee on Agriculture and Natural Resources) -- Relating to *Canis lupus*; declaring an emergency.

1-27(H) Pre-session Released to the Public.  
2-1 First reading. Referred to Speaker's desk.  
2-4 Public Hearing scheduled.

Ratifies decision of State Fish and Wildlife Commission to remove *Canis lupus* from state list of endangered species.

**HB4041** By Representative BUCKLEY (Pre-session filed.) -- Relating to local governments; declaring an emergency.

1-27(H) Pre-session Released to the Public.  
2-1 First reading. Referred to Speaker's desk.

Removes products of seed from statute prohibiting local governments from inhibiting or preventing production of seed.

**HB4042** Introduced and printed pursuant to House Rule 12.00. Pre-session filed (at the request of House Interim Committee on Human Services and Housing) -- Relating to general assistance.

1-27(H) Pre-session Released to the Public.  
2-1 First reading. Referred to Speaker's desk.  
2-3 Public Hearing scheduled.

Creates general assistance project administered by Department of Human Services.

**HB4043** Introduced and printed pursuant to House Rule 12.00. Pre-session filed (at the request of House Interim Committee on Human Services and Housing) -- Relating to assessments for real property transactions; prescribing an effective date; providing for revenue raising that requires approval by a three-fifths majority.

1-27(H) Pre-session Released to the Public.  
2-1 First reading. Referred to Speaker's desk.

Exempts from taxation amounts received from sale of real property to housing authority at price below fair market value.

**HB4044** By Representative BARKER (Pre-session filed.) -- Relating to pawnbroker records; declaring an emergency.

1-27(H) Pre-session Released to the Public.  
2-1 First reading. Referred to Speaker's desk.  
Public Hearing and Work Session scheduled.

Permits pawnbroker to keep register or record in electronic form and to deliver register or record kept in electronic form to local police agency in electronic form.

**HB4045** By Representative BARKER (Pre-session filed.) -- Relating to firearm crime sentencing.

1-27(H) Pre-session Released to the Public.  
2-1 First reading. Referred to Speaker's desk.  
2-3 Public Hearing and Possible Work Session scheduled.

Establishes mandatory minimum sentences for crimes of unlawful possession of a firearm and felon in possession of a firearm.

**HB4046** By Representatives KRIEGER, HELM, WITT, Senator ROBLAN (Pre-session filed.) -- Relating to violations of wildlife laws.

1-27(H) Pre-session Released to the Public.  
2-1 First reading. Referred to Speaker's desk.  
2-2 Public Hearing scheduled.  
2-4 Work Session scheduled.

Increases damages for unlawful taking or killing of wildlife.

**HB4047** Introduced and printed pursuant to House Rule 12.00. Pre-session filed (at the request of House Interim Committee on Transportation and Economic Development) -- Relating to speed limits on highways that traverse state lines; declaring an emergency.

1-27(H) Pre-session Released to the Public.  
2-1 First reading. Referred to Speaker's desk.  
Public Hearing scheduled.  
2-3 Work Session scheduled.

Increases speed limit for certain highways.

**HB4048** Introduced and printed pursuant to House Rule 12.00. Pre-session filed (at the request of House Interim Committee on Transportation and Economic Development) -- Relating to reallocation of moneys for transportation projects; declaring an emergency.

1-27(H) Pre-session Released to the Public.  
2-1 First reading. Referred to Speaker's desk.  
Public Hearing scheduled.  
2-3 Work Session scheduled.

Reallocates moneys for transportation projects.

**HB4049** Introduced and printed pursuant to House Rule 12.00. Pre-session filed (at the request of House Interim Committee on Transportation and Economic Development) -- Relating to economic development; declaring an emergency.

1-27(H) Pre-session Released to the Public.  
2-1 First reading. Referred to Speaker's desk.

Establishes Task Force on Economic Development.

**HB4050** By Representative SMITH WARNER; Representatives DOHERTY, FREDERICK, KOMP, MCLAIN, NATHANSON (Pre-session filed.) -- Relating to the Policy Advisory Council on Summer Learning; declaring an emergency.

1-27(H) Pre-session Released to the Public.  
2-1 First reading. Referred to Speaker's desk.  
Public Hearing and Possible Work Session scheduled.

Creates Policy Advisory Council on Summer Learning.

**HB4051** By Representative KOMP, Senator STEINER HAYWARD; Representatives BUCKLEY, HUFFMAN, MCLANE, RAYFIELD, WHISNANT, Senators BOQUIST, MONROE, ROBLAN (Pre-session filed.) -- Relating to legislative review of the implementation of legislative policies; declaring an emergency.

1-27(H) Pre-session Released to the Public.  
2-1 First reading. Referred to Speaker's desk.

Creates Joint Committee on Strategic Public Policy Review to undertake review of major public policies in specified subject areas.

**HB4052** Introduced and printed pursuant to House Rule 12.00. Pre-session filed (at the request of House Interim Committee on Business and Labor for Oregon Chiropractic Association) -- Relating to medical services provided to injured workers.

1-27(H) Pre-session Released to the Public.  
2-1 First reading. Referred to Speaker's desk.

Prohibits employer or insurer from requiring injured worker to obtain non-emergency medical services from specific provider.

**HB4053** Introduced and printed pursuant to House Rule 12.00. Pre-session filed (at the request of House Interim Committee on Business and Labor) -- Relating to brewery licensees.

1-27(H) Pre-session Released to the Public.  
2-1 First reading. Referred to Speaker's desk.

2-3 Public Hearing and Work Session scheduled.

Expands permissible activities for brewery licensee.

**HB4054** Introduced and printed pursuant to House Rule 12.00. Pre-session filed (at the request of House Interim Committee on Business and Labor) – Relating to minimum wage; declaring an emergency.

1-27(H) Pre-session Released to the Public.  
2-1 First reading. Referred to Speaker's desk.

Increases Oregon minimum wage rate in graduated steps to \$13.50 per hour by 2019.

**HB4055** By Representative DAVIS (Pre-session filed.) – Relating to transportation; prescribing an effective date; providing for revenue raising that requires approval by a three-fifths majority.

1-27(H) Pre-session Released to the Public.  
2-1 First reading. Referred to Speaker's desk.

Modifies list of low carbon fuels that may be used to meet low carbon fuel standards.

**HB4056** Introduced and printed pursuant to House Rule 12.00. Pre-session filed (at the request of Joint Interim Committee on Information Management and Technology) – Relating to sharing geospatial framework data among public bodies; declaring an emergency.

1-27(H) Pre-session Released to the Public.  
2-1 First reading. Referred to Speaker's desk.

Requires public body to share geospatial framework data of which public body is custodian with other public bodies if public body may do so using existing data and existing resources and without additional cost.

**HB4057** By Representatives WHISNANT, GALLEGOS, SPRENGER (Pre-session filed.) – Relating to moneys allocated from the State School Fund for students from families in poverty; declaring an emergency.

1-27(H) Pre-session Released to the Public.  
2-1 First reading. Referred to Speaker's desk.  
2-5 Public Hearing and Possible Work Session scheduled.

Directs Department of Education to prepare report related to educational performance of students from families in poverty.

**HB4058** By Representatives HACK, WILLIAMSON, Senator HASS; Representatives BARKER, BARRETO, BOONE, DOHERTY, ESQUIVEL, EVANS, FAGAN, GILLIAM, GOMBERG, HOYLE, KENNEMER, KRIEGER, NOSSE, OLSON, STARK, WHISNANT, WILSON, Senators BEYER, BOQUIST, BURDICK, FERRIOLI, GELSER, GIROD, KNOPP, MONNES ANDERSON, STEINER HAYWARD, THATCHER, THOMSEN (Pre-session filed.) – Relating to permissible corporate action when a shareholder fails to comply with public disclosure laws; declaring an emergency.

1-27(H) Pre-session Released to the Public.  
2-1 First reading. Referred to Speaker's desk.

Permits corporation with shares that are registered under securities law of this state or under federal securities law to reject vote, consent, waiver or proxy authorization if shareholder has not complied with public disclosure requirements of securities law of this state or federal securities law.

**HB4059** By Representatives POST, KOMP (Pre-session filed.) – Relating to funding services for women other than types of abortions on which federal moneys may not be spent; providing that this Act shall be referred to the people for their approval or rejection.

1-27(H) Pre-session Released to the Public.

2-1 First reading. Referred to Speaker's desk.

Requires Oregon Health Authority to establish grant program for purpose of making grants to entities that provide services related to encouraging and assisting pregnant women in carrying their pregnancy to term.

**HB4060** By Representatives WILSON, GOMBERG, HOYLE; Representatives BARRETO, KRIEGER, LIVELY, OLSON, STARK, Senators BEYER, FERRIOLI, HANSELL, KRUSE, MONNES ANDERSON, MONROE, PROZANSKI, ROBLAN, STEINER HAYWARD (Pre-session filed.) – Relating to industrial hemp; declaring an emergency.

1-27(H) Pre-session Released to the Public.  
2-1 First reading. Referred to Speaker's desk.
