HOUSE BILLS

- [HB3373](#) Sponsored by Representative FAHEY -- Relating to taxpayers; prescribing an effective date.**
3-16(H) First reading. Referred to Speaker's desk.
Establishes office of Taxpayer Advocate in Department of Revenue.
- [HB3374](#) Sponsored by Representative MOORE-GREEN -- Relating to the reduction of felony charges.**
3-16(H) First reading. Referred to Speaker's desk.
Provides that when court reduces felony conviction to Class A misdemeanor after person's completion of probation, person for purposes of law is deemed not to have been previously convicted of felony.
- [HB3375](#) Sponsored by Representative SMITH DB -- Relating to floating offshore wind energy; prescribing an effective date.**
3-16(H) First reading. Referred to Speaker's desk.
Establishes goal of planning for development of three gigawatts of commercial scale floating offshore wind energy projects within federal waters off Oregon Coast by 2030.
- [HB3376](#) Sponsored by Representative NOSSE -- Relating to movie theaters; declaring an emergency.**
3-16(H) First reading. Referred to Speaker's desk.
Directs Oregon Business Development Department to develop and implement program to award grants to operators of movie theaters closed to public due to public health restrictions related to COVID-19.
- [HB3377](#) Sponsored by Representative SANCHEZ; Representative WILLIAMS -- Relating to substance use; declaring an emergency.**
3-16(H) First reading. Referred to Speaker's desk.
Establishes Addiction Crisis Recovery Fund.
- [HB3378](#) Sponsored by Representatives WRIGHT, LEIF, Senator ANDERSON; Representatives GOMBERG, SMITH DB, WEBER -- Relating to Shutter Creek Correctional Institution.**
3-16(H) First reading. Referred to Speaker's desk.
Directs Department of Corrections to continue to operate Shutter Creek Correctional Institution.
- [HB3379](#) Sponsored by Representative SCHOUTEN (at the request of Benjamin Hoffman, MD) -- Relating to crib bumper pads; declaring an emergency.**
3-16(H) First reading. Referred to Speaker's desk.
Prohibits manufacturing, retrofitting, selling, leasing, subletting or otherwise placing into stream of commerce any crib bumper pads or crib equipped with crib bumper pads.
- [HB3380](#) Sponsored by Representative SCHOUTEN (at the request of Unchained at Last) -- Relating to marriage.**
3-16(H) First reading. Referred to Speaker's desk.
Modifies description of marriage.
- [HB3381](#) Sponsored by Representative HAYDEN -- Relating to health insurance; declaring an emergency.**
3-16(H) First reading. Referred to Speaker's desk.
Directs Oregon Health Authority, in collaboration with Department of Consumer and Business Services, Public Employees' Benefit Board and Oregon Educators Benefit Board, to design health benefit plans to offer to public employees in 2023 plan year.
