HOUSE BILLS:

HB 4003 **REV** **dp** **02/11/2014** **Bentz**
 Generally updates Oregon’s date of connection to certain federal laws from January 3, 2013 to December 31, 2013. Updates statutes pertaining to the tax qualification status of the Public Employees Retirement System plans, to unemployment insurance, and to the Oregon 529 College Savings Network. Includes income tax provisions pertaining to the definition of charitable organizations, federal Adjusted Gross Income (for the purposes of Oregon’s Elderly Rental Assistance), rules for S-corporation representation before magistrate, the Department of Revenue, and the Oregon Tax Court. Specifies that interest and penalties will not be assessed for tax deficiencies attributable to the federal law connection changes in this Act. Specifies that if a refund is due a taxpayer for a tax year beginning before January 1, 2014 due to any retroactive treatment from these federal tax law connection changes then the refund will be paid without interest. Requires taxpayers to file an amended return for changes in Oregon’s law due to these federal tax law changes for tax years beginning before January 1, 2014; requires the Department of Revenue to make changes to tax returns for taxpayers who do not file amended returns. (Committee Vote: 9-0-0)

HOUSE BILLS:

HB 4007 **ED** **dp** **02/11/2014** **Gelser**
 Prohibits district school board from imposing time limitation on consent given to resident student to attend schools of another school district. Requires district school board to give consent to enable student whose legal residence changes to different school district during school year to complete school year in school district. Allows district school board that administers lottery selection process to give priority for 2014-2015 school year to nonresident students who received consent from board for 2013-2014 school year. Declares emergency, effective on passage. (Committee Vote: 8 - 0 - 1)

HB 4050 **A-Eng** **HC** **dpa PE** **02/11/2014** **Harker**
 Specifies that insurer may not issue or deliver a policy against the risk of economic loss assumed under less than fully insured employee health benefit plan to an employer group with fewer than 51 employees. Declares emergency, effective on passage. (Committee Vote: 8 - 0 - 1)

HB 4081 A-Eng JUD dpa PE 02/11/2014 Berger

Allows Attorney General to deny, revoke, or suspend registration of charitable organization that willfully fails to file registration statement or annual report, makes misleading or false statements on filing documents, or operates in violation of Charitable Trust and Corporation Act. Requires written notice of basis for denial, revocation, or suspension of registration, with period for correction. Allows Attorney General to impose fine and order charitable organization to cease soliciting or accepting charitable donations. Defines "charitable fiduciary." Changes periodic reporting requirement to annual reporting requirement. (Committee Vote: 8 - 0 - 1)
