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Recognizes and honors Sergeant Scott Collins and Reserve Deputy Mark Whitehead for their service to this state. (Committee Vote: 9 - 0 - 0)

**HOUSE BILLS:**

<a href="#"><u>HB 4007</u></a>	ED	dp	02/11/2014	Gelser
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Prohibits district school board from imposing time limitation on consent given to resident student to attend schools of another school district. Requires district school board to give consent to enable student whose legal residence changes to different school district during school year to complete school year in school district. Allows district school board that administers lottery selection process to give priority for 2014-2015 school year to nonresident students who received consent from board for 2013-2014 school year. Declares emergency, effective on passage. (Committee Vote: 8 - 0 - 1)

<a href="#"><u>HB 4025</u></a>	VET	dp	02/12/2014	Esquivel
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Clarifies that maximum amount of home or farm loan made by Oregon Department of Veterans' Affairs to eligible individuals applies to each of four possible loans. Declares emergency, effective on passage. (Committee Vote: 7 - 0 - 0)

<a href="#"><u>HB 4050</u></a>	A-Eng	HC	dpa PE	02/11/2014	Harker
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Specifies that insurer may not issue or deliver a policy against the risk of economic loss assumed under less than fully insured employee health benefit plan to an employer group with fewer than 51 employees. Declares emergency, effective on passage. (Committee Vote: 8 - 0 - 1)

<a href="#"><u>HB 4057</u></a>	VET	dp	02/12/2014	Whisnant
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Requires certain entities report to appropriate legislative committees by October 1, 2014, on application of military training or experience toward obtaining licensure, certification, or other authorization to engage in profession. Declares emergency, effective on passage. (Committee Vote: 7 - 0 - 0)

**HB 4081** A-Eng      JUD                      dpa PE                      02/11/2014                      Berger

Allows Attorney General to deny, revoke, or suspend registration of charitable organization that willfully fails to file registration statement or annual report, makes misleading or false statements on filing documents, or operates in violation of Charitable Trust and Corporation Act. Requires written notice of basis for denial, revocation, or suspension of registration, with period for correction. Allows Attorney General to impose fine and order charitable organization to cease soliciting or accepting charitable donations. Defines “charitable fiduciary.” Changes periodic reporting requirement to annual reporting requirement. (Committee Vote: 8 - 0 - 1)

**HB 4119**                      BL                      dp                      02/11/2014                      Hoyle

Permits contracting agency, when directly appointing certain consultants, to solicit or use the consultant’s pricing policy or proposal or other pricing information to determine consultant’s compensation only after the contracting agency has selected the candidate and before entering into a contract with the consultant. Declares emergency, effective on passage. (Committee Vote: Ayes, 8 – Fagan, Holvey, Kennemer, Matthews, Thatcher, Thompson, Witt, Doherty; Nays, 3 – Barton, Freeman, Weidner)

**HB 4133**                      RULES                      dpa PE                      02/12/2014                      Barnhart

Directs Legislative Counsel (LC) and Oregon Department of Justice (DOJ) to review statute laws and identify those that are outdated, obsolete, or duplicative of other laws. Authorizes LC, in consultation with DOJ, to prepare measures for odd-numbered year regular session to repeal or amend statutes so identified. Requires report explaining reason for statutory modification to accompany each measure and be included in legislative record. Limits amendments to measures. Sunsets on January 2, 2018. Declares emergency, effective upon passage. (Committee Vote: 6 - 3 - 0)

Urges Congress to enhance safety standards for new and existing rail cars used to transport crude oil and other flammable liquids. Urges Congress to direct Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration to strengthen standards for new tank cars and require existing cars used for transporting hazardous materials be promptly retrofitted with advance safety technology or, if not upgraded, phased out of service. (Committee Vote: 9 - 0 - 1)
