(Possible Rule Suspension)

HB 4011 A-Eng **BL** **dpa PE** **02/12/2014** **Witt**
 Clarifies that county or city may not require precious metal secondhand dealer, that is also licensed pawnbroker, to provide photograph of precious metal item acquired in pawn transaction. Permits pawnbroker to charge \$1 fee to renew placement of firearm. Changes delivery method of notice to pledgor, at risk of forfeiting pledge securing loan of at least \$1,500, to regular mail. Adds 30-day grace period to redeem or renew if loan is less than \$500. Declares emergency, effective on passage. (Committee Vote: 11 - 0 - 0)

HB 4014 **BL** **dp** **02/12/2014** **Krieger**
 Allows immediate termination of portable electronic insurance policy without notice if the customer ceases to have wireless service with the limited licensee who is the vendor policyholder. Provides that if insurer or supervising entity does not provide timely notice of termination of coverage under portable electronic insurance, then insurance continues even if enrolled customer exhausts aggregate liability limit until insurer or supervising entity provides notice of termination. Becomes operative July 1, 2014. Declares emergency, effective on passage. (Committee Vote: 11 - 0 - 0)

HB 4021 A-Eng **VET** **dpa PE res sub WM** **02/12/2014** **Matthews**
 Requires public universities and community colleges charge in-state tuition of veteran graduate student with either honorable discharge or general discharge under honorable conditions, beginning September 15, 2014, if physical presence in Oregon shown within 12 months of enrollment. (Committee Vote: 7 - 0 - 0)

HB 4041 A-Eng EE dpa PE 02/12/2014 Lininger
 Expands energy improvement program by authorizing local governments to facilitate private financing of energy improvements by property owners. Authorizes local government establishing program to impose requirements to ensure that cost of financed improvements do not exceed cumulative energy cost savings over life of improvements. Modifies definition of "qualifying real property" to exclude single-family residential dwellings. Requires that local government not enter into loan agreement or facilitate financial agreement unless owner: 1) Provided written notice to all mortgagees of property that owner intends to enter into loan or financing agreement; and, 2) Received written consent from mortgagees stating loan or financing agreement does not constitute event of default or give rise to any remedies under terms of the mortgage loan agreement. Declares emergency, effective on passage. (Committee Vote: Ayes, 8 – Bentz, Boone, Johnson, Lininger, Reardon, Smith Warner, Vega Pederson, Bailey; Nays, 1 – Whitsett)

HB 4051 BL dp 02/12/2014 Kennemer
 Permits property and casualty insurer, under specified conditions, to post insurance policy and endorsements on insurer's website instead of mailing the documents. (Committee Vote: 11 - 0 - 0)

HB 4052 A-Eng BL dpa PE 02/12/2014 Weidner
 Stipulates that electronic record that provides or delivers a notice, offer, disclosure, document, form, correspondence, information or other communication required or permitted under the Oregon insurance laws satisfies requirements for provision or availability to consumer in writing. Provides that if proof of mailing of notice is sufficient proof of notice, the confirmation of electronic delivery is sufficient proof of notice. Allows oral communication, or the recording of, to qualify as a notice or document delivered by electronic means as long as the insurer can reliably store and reproduce the oral communication or the recording of the oral communication. Declares emergency, effective on passage. (Committee Vote: 11 - 0 - 0)

HB 4094 A-Eng JUD dpa PE 02/12/2014 Doherty
 Specifies that a person under 21 years of age who contacts emergency medical services or law enforcement for medical assistance for self or others due to alcohol consumption is immune from prosecution under minor in possession statute. Applies only if evidence of possession is obtained as result of person seeking assistance. Specifies exemption does not extend to other crimes or offenses. (Committee Vote: 9 - 0 - 0)

HB 4148 A-Eng REV dpa PE 02/12/2014 Nathanson
 Changes interest rate accruing on deferred taxes under homestead property tax deferral program from six percent compounded annually to six percent per annum. (Committee Vote: 9-0-0)
