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HOUSE BILLS:

HB 4071 **RULES** **dp** **02/19/2014** **Gilliam, Williamson**
 Directs Oregon Historical Society (OHS) to raise funds and commission statue of Mark Odom Hatfield, to be placed in National Statuary Hall in United States Capitol. Directs OHS provide for return of Jason Lee statue to suitable location in Salem. Establishes National Statuary Hall Review Task Force to study and make recommendations to retain or replace Oregon’s statues in National Statuary Hall Collection. Requires President of Senate and Speaker of House of Representatives to activate task force before task force members can be appointed or task force can take any action. Declares emergency, effective on passage. (Committee Vote: Ayes, 6 – Barnhart, Berger, Harker, Smith Warner, Hoyle; Nays, 3 – Holvey, Jenson, Kennemer)

HB 4155 **RULES** **dp** **02/20/2014** **Berger**
 Authorizes Public Employees Retirement System Board to establish procedures for recovering administrative costs from participating public employers for providing to those employers information or services needed to report in compliance with generally accepted accounting principles. Declares emergency, effective on passage. (Committee Vote: 9 - 0 - 0)

SENATE BILLS:

SB 1518 **BL** **dp** **02/20/2014** **Matthews, Doherty**
 Modifies definition of “supervisory employee” for purposes of public employee collective bargaining law. Specifies that firefighters who assign, transfer, or direct work of other employees, but do not have authority to hire, discharge, or impose economic discipline on those employees, are not supervisory employees. Declares emergency; effective on passage. (Committee Vote: Ayes, 9 – Barton, Fagan, Freeman, Holvey, Kennemer, Matthews, Thompson, Witt, Doherty; Nays, 1 – Thatcher)

SB 1519 A-Eng HC dp 02/20/2014 Clem
 Requires dentist to test, at least weekly, autoclave or other heat sterilization device. Directs the Oregon Board of Dentistry to dismiss disciplinary matter that is pending on effective date of this Act if the matter concerns whether the dentist tested the autoclave or other heat sterilization device less frequently than weekly. Directs the Board, with respect to licensee who the Board disciplined for autoclave or heat sterilization device testing less than weekly, to remove the licensee's name from website where the name is posted in connection with such disciplinary action and to pay licensee amount equal to any civil penalty imposed by the Board pursuant to such action. Specifies that the disciplined licensee may not bring cause of action against the entity that tested the licensee's device on grounds related to that testing. Declare emergency, effective on passage. (Committee Vote: 8 - 0 - 1)

SB 1526 A-Eng HC dp 02/20/2014 Kennemer
 Requires Oregon Health Authority (OHA) to investigate if Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) would approve matching funds from federal Children's Health Insurance Program (CHIP) to state expenditures for subsidizing health insurance costs on insurance provided by commercial insurer to eligible children for the Health Care for All Oregon Children Program. Directs OHA to report findings to interim health care committees by September 15, 2014. (Committee Vote: 8 - 0 - 1)

SB 1535 REV dp 02/19/2014 Barnhart
 Limits Investment of local funds to statutory investment pool. Authorizes State Treasurer to require local or tribal governments to enter into investment agreement as condition of placing funds in investment pool. (Committee Vote: 7-0-2)

SB 1567 A-Eng BL dp 02/19/2014 Kennemer
 Modifies reinstatement rights of state management service employees who have immediate prior former regular status in classified service. (Committee Vote: 10 - 0 - 1)

SB 1574 A-Eng ED dp 02/19/2014 Gelser
 Clarifies that standards for dual credit programs must establish manner by which students in grades 9 through 12 may earn course credit for both high school and community college or public university. (Committee Vote: 8 - 0 - 1)

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SB 1577 A-Eng HC dp 02/20/2014 Harker

Requires Department of State Police and all sheriffs and municipal police departments to adopt written policies relating to missing vulnerable adults on or before January 1, 2015. Specifies that missing vulnerable adults include individuals impaired with mental condition, intellectual or developmental disability or brain injury. Requires Oregon Health Authority to request specified information from potential contractors and, if certain conditions are met, to request proposals to establish and operate systems and technologies designed to detect and prevent improper payments (e.g. fraud) in the state medical assistance programs. Declares emergency, effective on passage. (Committee Vote: 8 - 0 - 1)

SB 1579 A-Eng HC dp 02/20/2014 Greenlick

Requires health benefit plans with prescription drug benefits and coordinated care organizations to each adopt a policy for synchronization refill dates of patients' prescription drugs. (Committee Vote: 8 - 0 - 1)

HOUSE BILLS:

HB 4055 A-Eng REV dpa PE 02/20/2014 Berger

Extends tax on customer access to 9-1-1 emergency reporting system from prepaid telecommunications service customers, requires Department of Revenue to establish by rule policies and procedures for collection of tax imposed on prepaid services and on fixed interconnected Voice over Internet Protocol service. Directs department to report on administration of tax imposed on fixed interconnected Voice over Internet Protocol service to legislative committee on revenue. (Committee Vote: 7 - 0 - 2)
