Authorizes Department of Human Services (DHS) to appear as party in juvenile court proceeding without appearance of Attorney General at any hearing held after hearing required by ORS 419B.305, and in any proceeding where district attorney appears on behalf of state and positions of DHS and state are not in conflict. Sunsets June 30, 2015. Declares emergency, effective on passage. (Committee Vote: 9 - 0 - 0)

Prohibits bad-faith claims of patent infringement. Allows recipient of claim to bring action under Unlawful Trade Practices Act. Permits Attorney General to investigate bad-faith claims and specifies acts or omission that court may consider in finding bad-faith claim. Specifies acts that evidence infringement claim made in good faith. Becomes operative 91 days after effective date. Declares emergency; effective on passage. (Committee Vote: 9 - 0 - 0)

Changes penalty when employee unknowingly or unintentionally sells alcohol to a minor while operating a store checkout device from Class A misdemeanor to Class A violation. Clarifies offense of endangering welfare of minor is Class A violation when person sells device for smoking tobacco to person under 18 years of age. Declares emergency; effective on passage. (Committee Vote: 9 - 0 - 0)

**SB 1548** A-Eng HC dpa PE 02/20/2014 Lively  
 Amends certain statutes referencing “physician” to include “physician assistant” and “nurse practitioner.” Deletes language referencing tanning facilities and certain statutes relating to health care insurance. Adds physician assistant language for purposes relating to assistive telecommunication for persons with disabilities. Deletes “physician” and replaces with “provider” in two locations. Becomes effective July 1, 2014. (Committee Vote: 8 - 0 - 1)

**SB 1557** TED dp 02/20/2014 Doherty  
 Specifies when a vehicle dealer has received certificate of title or other primary ownership document for purpose of the offense of failure to provide a clear title. Narrows the scope of the exception to the offense of failure to provide a clear title. Declares emergency, effective on passage. (Committee Vote: 8 - 0 - 2)
