HB 4050 B-Eng HC concur 02/26/2014 Harker
 Deletes requirement that insurer may not issue or deliver policy against risk of economic loss assumed under less than fully insured employee health benefit plan to employer group with fewer than 51 employees. Declares emergency, effective on passage. **Senate amendments delete current prohibition language.** (Senate vote: 29-0)

HB 4058 A-Eng HEWD concur 02/26/2014 Gorsek
 Amends 40-40-20 education goals, contained in ORS 351.009, to include apprenticeship programs registered with State Apprenticeship and Training Council. **Senate amendments move operative language to separate subsection of ORS 351.009.** (Senate vote: 29-0)

HB 4074 B-Eng HC concur 02/26/2014 Greenlick
 Authorizes the Board of Medical Imaging to waiver requirements for individual who has substantial experiences, as determined by the Board, and who is a medical imaging employee of a rural hospital. Specifies any health care practitioner may order or interpret medical imaging procedures if such procedures are within the practitioner’s scope of authority as determined by the agency that licensed the licensee. Declares emergency, effective on passage. **Senate amendments provide clarification of the scope of authority language.** (Senate vote: 29-0)

HB 4111 B-Eng TED concur 02/26/2014 Read

Establishes Public Infrastructure Commission to identify Oregon's public infrastructure needs, review and examine tools available to provide funding for public infrastructure projects, research innovative financing tools, determine legal impediments, and receive determinations from State Treasurer. Requires government entities preparing infrastructure projects with total capital expenditure exceeding \$50 million, of which at least \$20 million is awarded by Legislative Assembly or state agency, to submit description of proposed project to State Treasurer in early stage of project planning. Specifies that State Treasurer or designee will screen project to determine whether it would benefit from private capital and innovative procurement methods. Provides exceptions. Sunsets provisions on January 2, 2016. Directs Governor and State Treasurer to appoint representatives to West Coast Infrastructure Exchange. Declares emergency, effective on passage. **Senate amendments clarify exception from screening process.** (Senate vote: Ayes, 22; Nays, 7 – Ferrioli, George, Girod, Kruse, Olsen, Thomsen, Whitsett)

HOUSE BILLS:**HB 4054 A-Eng RULES dpa PE 02/25/2014 Vega Pederson**

Provides ballot language corresponding to Referendum 301 (Senate Bill 833, 2013). Declares emergency, effective on passage. (Committee Vote: Ayes, 6 – Barnhart, Harker, Holvey, Jenson, Smith Warner, Hoyle; Nays, 3 – Berger, Hicks, Kennemer)

SENATE BILLS:**HB 1509 A-Eng ED dp 02/25/2014 Sprenger**

Allows district school board to enter into approved written agreement with federally recognized Native American tribe in Oregon for use of mascot that represents, is associated with or is significant to tribe. Requires agreement to describe acceptable uses of mascot, comply with State Board of Education rules and be approved by board. Requires board to approve agreement that meets requirements. Requires board to adopt rules by January 1, 2017. Declares emergency, effective on passage. (Committee Vote: Ayes, 7 – Fagan, Gomberg, Huffman, Parrish, Sprenger, Whisnant, Gelser; Nays, 2 – Gorsek, Reardon)

SB 1520 B-Eng BL dpa PE 02/24/2014 Holvey

Exempts from registration requirements those securities issued by renewable energy cooperative corporations to members of the cooperative corporations as evidence of membership, or to show members' respective interests in assets, reserves or patronage dividends. Becomes operative October 1, 2014. Declares emergency, effective on passage. (Committee Vote: Ayes, 8 – Fagan, Holvey, Kennemer, Matthews, Thatcher, Thompson, Weidner, Doherty; Nays, 2- Barton, Witt)

SB 1555 A-Eng AGNR dp 02/25/2014 Krieger

Caps amount of bonds or other securities required of bidder or purchaser in connection with forest product sale by State Forester to not more than \$500,000. Limits time to no later than 180 days for State Forester to return unexpended amount from performance bond or other security after earlier of completion of operations or termination date in sales contract. Applies revised provisions to bond or other security requirements for sale of forest products by Department of State Lands. Applies to forest product sales occurring on or after July 1, 2014. Declares emergency, effective upon passage. (Committee Vote: 9 - 0 - 0)

SB 1562 B-Eng HC dpa PE 02/25/2014 Greenlick, Conger

Modifies requirements for health insurance coverage of services, medications and supplies necessary for diabetes management during pregnancy. Clarifies notification requirements between practitioner and insurer. Directs the Oregon Health Insurance Exchange Corporation executive director to report to House and Senate Health Care Committees on the first meeting following sine die of the 2014 regular session with an updated business plan. Specifies topics to be included in business plan. Requires state agency to provide executive director of Oregon Health Insurance Exchange, without delay, any reports from an independent review, investigation or audit of the exchange conducted on or after October 1, 2013 if the report, audit, investigation was paid for (in part or entirely) by the state agency. Directs Exchange board of directors or executive director to make report publicly available upon request to any person, without delay. Adds emergency clause. (Committee Vote: 9 - 0 - 0)
