<u>HB 2339</u>	JUD	dp	02/06/2015	Williamson
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Requires courts to appoint qualified interpreter in criminal proceedings for non-English speaking victims, or victims who are persons with a disability, who seek to exercise victims' constitutional rights in court. Includes juvenile delinquency proceedings. Prohibits charging of fee to non-English speaking parties or victims. Allows victims to request new interpreter be appointed should victim be dissatisfied with interpreter appointed by court and prohibits appointment of interpreter who has conflict of interest with victims. Declares emergency; effective on passage. Please note: Has minimal fiscal impact, no statement issued. **(Committee Vote: 7 - 0 - 2)**

<u>HB 2432</u>	AGNR	dp	02/06/2015	Krieger
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Expands categories of land on which fireworks may be used to repel birds and other animals under permit issued by State Fire Marshall (Fire Marshall). Broadens eligible permit applicants to include land managers. Requires fireworks be purchased from licensed wholesaler and stored in accordance with Fire Marshall rules. Authorizes Fire Marshall to adopt rules for safe storage. Grants local governments concurrent enforcement authority with Fire Marshall for enforcement of storage related rules. Authorizes Fire Marshall to revoke permit for specified violations. Exempts State and Federal agencies from permit requirement in certain circumstances. Repeals ORS 480.122. Please note: Has minimal fiscal impact, no statement issued. **(Committee Vote: 8 - 0 - 1)**

<u>HB 2475</u>	AGNR	dp	02/06/2015	Esquivel
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Authorizes Oregon State Veterinary Medical Examining Board (Board) to impose fine of not more than \$100 on any permit or license holder regulated by Board for administrative or clerical violation that does not create risk of harm to public. **(Committee Vote: 8 - 0 - 1)**

<u>HB 2047</u>	RCLUW	dp	02/06/2015	Clem, Davis
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Adjusts reserve boundaries in comprehensive planning maps adopted by Metro and previously adjusted by Legislative Assembly. **(Committee vote: 7-0)**

HB 2173 **JUD** **dp** **02/06/2015** **Barton**
 Requires Secretary of State to report suspected fraud or other criminal activity found in course of audit to appropriate law enforcement agencies. Declares emergency; effective on passage.
(Committee vote: 8-0-1)

HB 2227 **JUD** **dp** **02/06/2015** **Gilliam**
 Clarifies that consensual sexual contact between elderly person and employee of facility who is also spouse of elderly person is not sexual abuse. **(Committee vote: 8-0-1)**

HB 2327 **JUD** **dp** **02/06/2015** **Barton**
 Allows Oregon State Bar (OSB) to petition court *ex parte* (by or for one party) to take immediate jurisdiction over attorney's law practice in certain cases where attorney has died, is disbarred, suspended from active practice of law, is incarcerated, or has abandoned the practice. Authorizes court to take immediate jurisdiction over affected practice as court determines necessary. Mandates that courts appoint OSB as custodian and that immediately upon appointment, OSB assume possession and control of all property falling within the court's assumed jurisdiction. Mandates that financial institutions holding funds in lawyer trust account release funds to OSB. Outlines process for distributing funds and managing papers and files. Revises process of notice and opportunity for hearing for affected attorney. Declares emergency, effective upon passage. **(Committee vote: 7-0-2)**

HB 2328 **JUD** **dp** **02/06/2015** **Greenlick**
 Clarifies which parties must appear in court proceedings by attorney and which parties are permitted to appear absent of counsel. Declares emergency, effective upon passage. **(Committee vote: 7-0-2)**

HB 2405 **ED** **dp** **02/06/2015** **McLain**
 Allows Department of Education to solicit and accept gifts, grants, donations, and other moneys from public and private sources for State School Fund. Declares emergency, effective on passage.
