HB 2335	JUD	dp	02/09/15	Post
Revises definition of “enter and remain unlawfully” in ORS 164.205 to mirror existing appellate interpretation (Committee vote: 7-0-2)				
Please note: Has minimal fiscal impact, no statement issued.				

HB 2372	JUD	dp	02/09/15	Olson
Requires certification by Department of Public Safety Standards and Training, rather than Board on Public Safety Standards and Training, before police officer may request urine test of person arrested for driving under the influence of intoxicants. Declares emergency, effective on passage (Committee vote: 6-0-3)				

HB 2380	JUD	dp	02/09/15	Williamson
Allows court in post-conviction relief proceeding, upon joint motion of the parties, to vacate judgment and order and remand proceeding to circuit court to reconsider judgment or order. Gives jurisdiction to circuit court to enter revised judgment or order upon remand. (Committee vote: 6-0-3)
