HOUSE BILLS:

<u>HB 2177</u>	JWM	dp	02/13/14	Hoyle
<p>Directs the Oregon Department of Transportation to provide the Secretary of State (SOS) with electronic records containing legal name, age, residence and citizenship information, and electronic signature, of each person who may qualify as a voter. Constitutes these records as a completed voter registration card. Directs the SOS to notify persons on how to decline registration and how to select a political party affiliation. Directs the SOS to register each nonregistered person who is qualified to vote as a voter, unless they decline registration within 21 days of notification. Increases maximum number of voters in precinct from 5,000 to 10,000. Establishes July 1, 2015, as date for determination of total number of registered voters in Oregon for purpose of maintaining status as minor political party for 2016 general election. Prohibits public record disclosure of voter registration information for persons under 18 years of age who are registered to vote. Declares emergency, effective on passage. <u>HB 2384</u>	JUD	dp	02/13/14	Barton
<p>Allows substituted service of certain investigative demands on natural persons to be accomplished in same manner as service on unnatural persons. Contains scrivener's changes. Applies to certain investigative demands issued on or after the effective date. (Committee vote: 7-0-2)</p>				

<u>HB 2603</u>	JUD	dp	02/13/14	Smith Warner
<p>Mandates that ORS 30.868 be known and may be cited as "Aaron's Law." (Committee vote: 9-0-0)</p>				

<u>HB 2763</u>	VET	dp	02/13/14	Fagan, Parrish
<p>Allows public employers to compensate deployed employees. Stipulates amount shall not exceed base salary on date of deployment. Declares emergency, effective on passage.(Committee vote: 7-0-0)</p>
