HOUSE BILLS:

<u>HB 2177</u>	JWM	dp	02/13/14	Hoyle
-----------------------	------------	-----------	-----------------	--------------

Directs the Oregon Department of Transportation to provide the Secretary of State (SOS) with electronic records containing legal name, age, residence and citizenship information, and electronic signature, of each person who may qualify as a voter. Constitutes these records as a completed voter registration card. Directs the SOS to notify persons on how to decline registration and how to select a political party affiliation. Directs the SOS to register each nonregistered person who is qualified to vote as a voter, unless they decline registration within 21 days of notification. Increases maximum number of voters in precinct from 5,000 to 10,000. Establishes July 1, 2015, as date for determination of total number of registered voters in Oregon for purpose of maintaining status as minor political party for 2016 general election. Prohibits public record disclosure of voter registration information for persons under 18 years of age who are registered to vote. Declares emergency, effective on passage. (Committee vote: 7-5-0)

<u>HB 2175-A</u>	CPGE	dpa PE	02/17/14	Stark

Deletes requirement that state agencies receiving all or part of funding from State Treasurer file with Secretary of State documentation of business reasons for exceptions to next-day deposit of funds with State Treasurer. Deletes requirement that commodity commissions file annual financial statements with Secretary of State. Moves filing deadline forward for commodity commissions to file annual financial statement with Department of Agriculture. Declares emergency, effective upon passage. (Committee vote: 7-0-0)

Renames crime of patronizing a prostitute to "commercial sexual solicitation." (Committee vote: 7-0-0)

<u>HB 2294-A</u>	HC	dpa PE	02/17/14	Lively

Requires Oregon Health Authority (OHA) to establish the Oregon Health Information Technology Program. Authorizes OHA to provide optional health information technology services (HIT) to support statewide healthcare and establish fees to cover cost of expanding HIT services. Allows OHA to participate in or fund HIT partnerships or collaboratives. Establishes the Health Information Technology Oversight Council under the Oregon Health Policy Board (OHPB), changes appointment authority from the Governor to the OHPB, and modifies the role of the Council to provide strategic and policy recommendations. Expands OHA scope to include certain activities to support the Oregon HIT program. Clarifies procurement procedures. Requires that OHA submit annual report to the Legislative Assembly. Declares emergency, effective on passage. (Committee vote: 8-0-1)

 Allows state agency to decline to assign debt of estate to private collection agency if estate has closed.
 Applies to debts owed as of effective date. Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2015. (Committee vote: 7-0-0)
