HOUSE BILLS:

(Carried over from Friday, February 20, 2015 Calendar)

HB 2175-A **CPGE** **dpa PE** **02/17/14** **Stark**
 Deletes requirement that state agencies receiving all or part of funding from State Treasurer file with Secretary of State documentation of business reasons for exceptions to next-day deposit of funds with State Treasurer. Deletes requirement that commodity commissions file annual financial statements with Secretary of State. Moves filing deadline forward for commodity commissions to file annual financial statement with Department of Agriculture. Declares emergency, effective upon passage. (Committee vote: 7-0-0)

HB 2206 **JUD** **dp** **02/17/14** **Taylor**
 Renames crime of patronizing a prostitute to "commercial sexual solicitation." (Committee vote: 7-0-0)

HB 2294-A **HC** **dpa PE** **02/17/14** **Lively**
 Requires Oregon Health Authority (OHA) to establish the Oregon Health Information Technology Program. Authorizes OHA to provide optional health information technology services (HIT) to support statewide healthcare and establish fees to cover cost of expanding HIT services. Allows OHA to participate in or fund HIT partnerships or collaboratives. Establishes the Health Information Technology Oversight Council under the Oregon Health Policy Board (OHPB), changes appointment authority from the Governor to the OHPB, and modifies the role of the Council to provide strategic and policy recommendations. Expands OHA scope to include certain activities to support the Oregon HIT program. Clarifies procurement procedures. Requires that OHA submit annual report to the Legislative Assembly. Declares emergency, effective on passage. (Committee vote: 8-0-1)

HB 2549 **CPGE** **dp** **02/17/14** **Greenlick**
 Allows state agency to decline to assign debt of estate to private collection agency if estate has closed. Applies to debts owed as of effective date. Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2015. (Committee vote: 7-0-0)

HOUSE BILLS:

HB 2330 **JUD** **dp** **02/19/14** **Barton**
 Allows converting business entity, limited liability corporation, or nonprofit corporation to file written declaration stating location where plan of conversion is on file and stating that converting entity will provide any owner with a copy of the plan upon request and without cost in lieu of submitting plans to Secretary of State (SOS). Modifies documents required to be filed with SOS upon approval of plan to merge or share exchange. Requires written notice of dissenters' rights be delivered to all shareholders entitled to notice when corporate action creating dissenters' rights is authorized by written consent without meeting. (Committee vote: 9-0-0)

HB 2331 **JUD** **dp** **02/19/14** **Williamson**
 Modifies Oregon Uniform Trust Code. Reinstates “early vesting rule” for vesting of trusts. Aligns Oregon separate share rule with federal tax code. Clarifies statutes on merging trusts or separating trusts into two or more trusts. Authorizes fiduciaries to include capital gains as Distributable Net Income (DNI) when such gains meet federal tax code requirements. Applies to trusts executed on or after effective date. (Committee vote: 9-0-0)

HB 2332 **JUD** **dp** **02/19/14** **Post**
 Allows parties to request certain documents without filing a request for modification of judgment when a judgment of marital annulment, dissolution or separation includes award for spousal support and any portion of obligation remains due and owing. (Committee vote: 8-0-1)

HB 2430 **JUD** **dp** **02/19/14** **Greenlick**
 Authorizes Department of Oregon State Police and State Fire Marshall to accept and distribute gifts, grants, donations and funds from any source, including services and property, to carry out duties of department or marshal. Declares emergency, effective on passage. (Committee vote: 8-0-1)

HB 2431 **JUD** **dp** **02/19/14** **Krieger**
 Authorizes the Department of Oregon State Police to adopt rules addressing physical examination of state police candidates. Applies to physical examinations administered on or after the effective date. (Committee vote: 8-0-1)

HB 2482 **REV** **dp** **02/19/14** **Smith Warner**
 Clarifies assessment responsibilities of Department of Revenue and County Assessor offices relating to valuation of industrial property. Requires county assessor to appraise property for five consecutive years following request by county for assessment responsibility of otherwise state-appraised industrial property. Clarifies appeals process. Defines terms. Applies to assessment years beginning on or after January 1, 2015 and property tax years beginning on or after July 1, 2015. (Committee vote: 9-0-0)
