 Allows circuit court judge to authorize execution of search warrant outside of issuing court’s judicial district if search relates to elder abuse offense, the object of search is financial records, and proper place for trial on offense is not known. Clarifies law to include searches relating to criminal mistreatment in first degree, identity theft, aggravated identity theft, computer crime, fraudulent use of a credit card, forgery, criminal possession of a forged instrument, theft, or aggravated theft. Changes name of Department of Community Colleges and Workforce Development Account to Office of Community Colleges and Workforce Development Account. Transfers rulemaking authority and designation as recipient of appropriations from Department of Community Colleges and Workforce Development to Higher Education Coordinating Commission. Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2015. (Committee vote: 9-0-0)

 Defines "inhalant delivery system." Amends laws relating to sale of tobacco products to, and the use of tobacco products by, minors. Expands the scope of the offense of endangering the welfare of a minor by knowingly causing sale of tobacco products to minors by including distribution and sale of inhalant delivery systems. Adds inhalants to the Oregon Clean Air Act, and defines "inhalant." Repeals laws relating to smoking in public that are duplicative or inconsistent with provisions of the Oregon Clean Air Act. Clarifies the exception also applies to devices approved by federal Food and Drug Administration. Allows healthcare facilities to allow inhalant delivery system on site for the purpose of administering medical marijuana. Directs Oregon Health Authority (OHA) to report on the consistency between state and federal regulations on or before February 1, 2019. Declares emergency, effective on passage. (Committee vote: Yeas: 7 - Buehler, Clem, Greenlick, Hayden, Keny-Guyer, Lively, Nosse Nays: 1 – Weidner Exc: 1 - Kennemer)

Abolishes Oregon Health Insurance Exchange Corporation and board of directors of corporation and transfers functions and duties to the Department of Consumer and Business Services (DCBS). Establishes the Health Insurance Exchange Fund, and specifies that unexpended balances will be transferred from Cover Oregon to the new Health Insurance Exchange Fund; funds are available for expenditure by DCBS beginning July 1, 2015. Authorizes DCBS director, the Oregon Health Authority and Cover Oregon to take action before the June 30, 2015 operative date. Creates 15-member Health Insurance Exchange Advisory Committee and specifies duties. Defines Small Business Health Options Program and allocates \$1 million to DCBS to spend on information technology portal. Specifies legislative reporting requirements. Declares emergency, effective on passage. (Committee vote: 5-0-0)

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
