<u>HB 2444</u>	RCLUW	dp	02/26/15	
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Authorizes Department of Agriculture to coordinate agricultural mediation services for disputes directly related to activities of the department and agricultural issues under jurisdiction of the department. Removes language regarding foreclosure mediations. Removes regulation on price cap for mediation services. Categorizes mediation as voluntary. Declares an emergency, effective on passage. (Committee vote: 6-0-1)

<u>HB 2007-A</u>	BL	dpa PE	02/26/14	Fagan
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Makes disciplinary action against employee who inquires about or discloses wage information an unlawful employment practice and provides employee a private right of action. Creates exception. (Committee vote: Yeas: 6 - Barton, Doherty, Evans, Fagan, Holvey, Nosse; Nays: 5 - Barreto, Esquivel, Heard, Kennemer, Weidner)

<u>HB 2213</u>	BL	dp	02/26/14	Evans
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Makes on-the-job safety issues an employment relation subject to collective bargaining for employees of Department of Corrections who have direct contact with inmates. (Committee vote: 9-0-2)

<u>HB 2404-A</u>	ED	dpa PE	02/26/14	McLain
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Adjusts school food and beverage nutritional standards to comply with federal food and beverage nutritional standards. Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2015. (Committee vote: 9-0-0)

<u>HB 2442-A</u>	HS	dpa PE	02/26/14	Keny-Guyer
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Replaces existing State Housing Council with Oregon Housing Stability Council (OHSC). Abolishes Advisory Committee on Energy and Community Development Incentive Advisory Board and transfers authority to OHSC. Abolishes Interagency Council on Hunger and Homelessness (ICHH) and transfers responsibility to OHSC. Authorizes Director to provide Oregon Housing and Community Services (OHCS) with financial and budgetary oversight. Transfers responsibility for Oregon Hunger Relief Task Force to Department of Human Services and defines funding mechanism. Clarifies name changes and usage. (Committee vote: 7-0-2)

<u>HB 2456</u>	RCLUW	dp	02/26/14	Helm
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Modifies optional method of evaluation of changes to urban growth boundary of city outside Metro with population of 10,000 or more. (Committee vote: 6-0-1)

HB 2480 **BL** **dp** **02/26/14** **Doherty**
 Directs Oregon Liquor Control Commission (OLCC) to charge application fee up to \$150 for issuance of new license or license following ownership change. Specifies application fee applies only to licenses with annual fee. Directs OLCC to refund fee under specified circumstances. Directs OLCC to adopt rules setting fee by class of license. (Committee vote: Yeas: 6 - Barton, Doherty, Evans, Holvey, Nosse, Fagan; Nays: 3 - Barreto, Weidner, Heard; Exc: 2 - Esquivel, Kennemer)

HB 2481 **BL** **dp** **02/26/14** **Barreto**
 Establishes \$50 fee to appeal a board of stewards ruling to Oregon Racing Commission. Directs Commission to refund fee under specified circumstances. Allows Commission to require appellant to pay costs incurred by State as a result of appeal if appellant withdraws appeal within 21 days of scheduled hearing date. Requires administrative law judge to award Commission costs and attorney fees if appellant fails, without good cause, to appear at hearing or if judge finds no objectively reasonable basis for appeal. (Committee vote: 9-0-2)

HB 2544 **BL** **dp** **02/26/14** **Doherty**
 Requires issue subject to collective bargaining during term of agreement that is not resolved through negotiation or mediation be resolved through binding arbitration. Requires matter be submitted for mediation before binding arbitration. Prohibits public employees from striking when issue subject to collective bargaining during term of agreement is subject to binding arbitration. (Committee vote: Yeas: 6 - Barton, Doherty, Evans, Fagan, Holvey, Nosse; Nays: 5 - Barreto, Esquivel, Heard, Kennemer, Weidner)

HB 2610-A **HS** **dpa PE** **02/26/14** **Gallegos**
 Specifies jurisdiction over safety and health inspection standards for agricultural workforce housing. Defines circumstances and procedure to obtain abatement and refund of applicable property taxes for July 1, 2014 through July 1, 2016. Takes effect 91st day after *sine die*. (Committee vote: 7-0-2)

HOUSE BILLS:

HB 2230 **VET** **dp** **02/27/15** **Nathanson**
 Requires Oregon Health Authority (OHA) notify Oregon Department of Veterans' Affairs (ODVA) upon receipt of self-identified information from veteran or active service member. Restricts notification to name and address. Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2015. Becomes operative January 1, 2016. (Committee vote: 6-0-1)

HB 2377 **CPGE** **dp** **02/27/15** **Nearman**
 Prohibits person from soliciting, requesting or otherwise inducing another person to provide personal information by impersonating a third person, without the third person's knowledge, authorization and consent. Creates exceptions for law enforcement and lawful investigators. Punishes violation as unlawful trade practice. Declares emergency, effective upon passage. (Committee vote: 7-0-0)

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HB 2383 **CPGE** **dp** **02/27/15** **Stark**
 Requires people soliciting purchase of business opportunities by telephone to make certain disclosures before completing transaction. Defines business opportunity. Becomes operative 91 days after effective date. Declares emergency, effective upon passage. (Committee vote: 7-0-0)

HB 2445-A **RCLUW** **dpa PE** **02/27/15** **Witt**
 Authorizes State Department of Agriculture (department) director to provide notice of quarantine areas by newspaper of general circulation in the quarantine area and by one or more additional methods. Eliminates mandate to department to declare hazard and establish control area in response to existence of eastern filbert blight. Eliminates references to Grade B milk. Authorizes department director to choose method for making noxious weed information available. Expands definitions dealing with plant pests, infections, and infestations. Amends definition of “certificate of analysis” as it pertains to biodiesel. Eliminates requirement that department give fuel dealers notice of threshold biodiesel production capacity. Repeals requirement that department study and monitor ethanol production. Repeals obsolete statutes providing for participation in defunct Interstate Compact on Pest Control. Modernizes language. (Committee vote: 6-0-1)

HB 2467-A **CPGE** **dpa PE** **02/27/15** **Buehler**
 Allows the Department of Consumer and Business Services (DCBS) to adopt rules regulating penalties, fees, and charges imposed on certain withdrawals from individual deferred annuity policies. Becomes operative January 1, 2016, and applies to contracts entered into on or after operative date. Declares emergency, effective upon passage. (Committee vote: 7-0-0)

HB 2476 **CPGE** **dp** **02/27/15** **Fagan**
 Allows Department of Administrative Services, with approval of Governor, to adopt by rule uniform policies and procedures affecting multiple state agencies, commissions and boards. Declares emergency, effective on passage. (Committee vote: 7-0-0)
