HOUSE BILLS:

<u>HB 2340-A</u>	JUD	dpa PE	03/04/15	Sprengrer
Restricts Social Security numbers, driver license numbers, and taxpayer identification numbers in certain court documents to last four digits of such numbers. Prohibits the inclusion of address of victim within judgment containing a money award in criminal action. Becomes operative January 1, 2016. Allows rulemaking prior to operative date. Declares emergency; effective on passage. (Committee vote: 9-0-0)				

<u>HB 2362</u>	JUD	dp	03/04/15	Williamson
Requires court to give greatest weight of consideration, when determining award for attorney fees, to benefit of person subject to protective proceeding by actions of party requesting attorney fees. (Committee vote: 9-0-0)

<u>HB 2439-A</u>	BL	dpa PE	03/04/15	Barreto
Allows Employment Department to dismiss request for hearing with Office of Administrative Hearings under specified circumstances. Specifies that if Department dismisses a hearings request, party may request a hearing on the dismissal. Declares emergency, effective on passage. (Committee vote: 10-0-1)

<u>HB 3014</u>	JUD	dp	03/04/15	Krieger
Changes definition of "grandparent" for purpose of notice of dependency proceeding and request for visitation or contact to including legal parents of child's legal parent, even when parental rights of child's legal parent have been terminated. (Committee vote: 9-0-0)
