Requires the Oregon Health Authority (OHA) and health benefit plans provide reimbursement or payment to the community assessment center to bill for child abuse medical assessments and related services. (Committee vote: 9-0-0)

Deletes prohibition against advertising by unregulated producer engaged in small-scale, on-premises sale of raw milk directly to consumer. (Committee vote: 9-0-0)

<u>HB 2560-A</u>	HC	dpa PE	03/10/15	Greenlick

Requires health benefit plan to cover cost of a colonoscopy for an insured who is 50 years of age or older and who has had a positive fecal immunochemical test result. Directs insurers to include coverage for the removal of polyps during a colonoscopy. Excludes health savings accounts from the coverage directive. Specifies effective date of January 1, 2017. Specifies that any patient with a positive fecal test with a grade A or B result using the criteria established by the U.S. Preventive Services Task Force have a follow-up colonoscopy. (Committee vote: 9-0-0)

Extends to January 2, 2026, the exemption allowing retired members of Public Employees Retirement System to be employed full time by public employer as nursing instructor or trainer for Department of Public Safety Standards and Training without loss of retirement benefits. (Committee vote: 10-0-1)

Authorizes Board of Parole and Post-Prison Supervision to require the appearance of either a District Attorney or the Attorney General at hearing setting or resetting release date of person. (Committee vote: 9-0-0)
