 Authorizes Labor Commissioner to issue temporary cease and desist order requiring employer to refrain from unlawful practice when there is reason to believe statutes governing prevailing wage rate, farm and construction labor contractors, wage and hour, and employment conditions have been violated. Authorizes Labor Commissioner to impose civil penalty when employer fails to pay wages on regular payday. Authorizes Labor Commissioner to administratively compel employer to provide bond when employer fails to establish and maintain a regular payday. (Committee vote Yeas: 6 - Barton, Doherty, Evans, Fagan, Holvey, Nosse; Nays: 5 - Barreto, Esquivel, Heard, Kennemer, Weidner)

 Authorizes Labor Commissioner to issue temporary cease and desist order when there is reason to believe statutes governing prevailing wage rate, farm and construction labor contractors, wage and hour, and employment conditions have been violated. Requires Commissioner to pay damages related to the enforcement of temporary cease and desist order if defendant prevails in contested case hearing or upon appeal of final order regarding a temporary cease and desist order. Damages include, but are not limited to, actual damages, reasonable attorney fees, and back pay to defendant's employees. (Filed by: Rep. Jim Weidner, Rep. Dallas Heard)

Authorizes Labor Commissioner to issue temporary cease and desist order when there is reason to believe statutes governing prevailing wage rate, farm and construction labor contractors, wage and hour, and employment conditions have been violated. Prohibits Commissioner from issuing temporary cease and desist order that would preclude production or distribution of perishable agricultural products. Requires Commissioner to pay reasonable attorney fees up to \$50,000 if defendant prevails in contested case hearing or upon appeal of final order regarding a temporary cease and desist order.
