<u>HB 2232-A</u>	HS	dpa PE	03/25/15	Taylor
Requires Department of Human Services (DHS) appoint advisory committee on coordination of statewide services for homeless and unaccompanied youth. Specifies committee role and composition. Requires DHS submit annual report to legislature by September 15. Declares emergency, effective on passage. (Committee vote: 8-0-1)

<u>HB 2334-A</u>	REV	dp	03/25/15	Vega Pederson
Allows payment of taxes, penalties, and interest found to be deficient to be made within 30 days after an order to specially designate a complaint to the Regular Division of the Tax Court from the Magistrate. Allows the taxpayer to file an affidavit alleging undue hardship within 30 days after receiving notice of a lack of this affidavit from the court. (Committee vote: 9-0-0)

<u>HB 2837</u>	TED	dp	03/26/15	Gomberg
Directs Department of Transportation to issue a certificate of exemption from the requirement to use a child safety system, safety belt or safety harness if nurse practitioner or physician assistant submits a statement on behalf of a person requesting the exemption. (Committee vote: 6-0-1)				

<u>HB 2880-A</u>	HC	dpa PE	03/25/15	Nosse
Specifies that a physician assistant (PA) may not practice fluoroscopy on a person unless the PA holds a certificate issued by the Board of Medical Imaging. Requires the PA to complete 80 hours of didactic and clinical training and pass the examination for certification. Modifies the supervising physician requirements. Directs the Board of Medical Imaging to issue the certificate. Becomes operative January 1, 2016. Declares an emergency, effective on passage. (Committee vote: 9-0-0)

HB 2981**TED****dp****03/26/15****Bentz**

Directs Department of Transportation to erect and maintain a Fallen Hero roadside memorial sign for Specialist Mabry James Anders. Declares emergency, effective on passage. (Committee vote: 6-0-1)

SENATE BILLS:**SB 482****TED****dp****03/26/15****Clem**

Authorizes the Oregon Business Development Department to appoint a Pacific Northwest Manufacturing Partnership Advisory Committee to advise the Department regarding the Pacific Northwest Manufacturing Partnership and manufacturing economic development within the Willamette Valley and Columbia Valley corridor. Directs Department to provide support to, and consult with, the Partnership. Requires Department and Advisory Committee to report to Legislative Assembly during active duration of Advisory Committee, beginning January 1, 2017. (Committee vote: 7-0-0)
