**HB 2259**                      **TED**                                      **dp CC**    **03/26/15**  
 Modifies the authority of the Department of Transportation to issue variance permits to operate self-loading log trucks. Authorizes the Department to issue a refund for payment of fuel taxes if a person pays both a fuel tax and a road assessment fee. (Committee vote: 6-0-1)

**HB 2400-A**                      **RCLUW**                                      **dpa PE**    **03/26/15**                      **Gomberg**  
 Extends deadline to submit report to April 1, 2015. Deems satisfied any report submitted prior to January 31, 2015. Requires Water Resources Commission to adopt rules to take effect on January 1, 2016. Ratifies and approves any lawful action of task force taken on or after February 2, 2015 and on or before June 30, 2015. Establishes new repeal date of January 1, 2016. Requires Water Resources Commission to make seasonally varying flows condition of new or existing water storage, aquifer recharge permit, or limited license for storage of water. Allows permit or license holder to request seasonally varying flows be altered based upon new information. Expands language of statute to include current holders of water storage, aquifer recharge permit, or limited license for storage of water to be used as determination for seasonally varying flows. Declares emergency, effective on passage. (Committee vote: 6-0-1)

**HB 2468-A**                      **HC**                      **dpa PE**                      **03/26/15**                      **Greenlick**  
 Creates standards for insurers’ provider networks. Clarifies that the adequacy requirements apply on a plan-specific basis. Grants Department of Consumer and Business Services (DCBS) rulemaking authority and specifies that rules relating to provider non-discrimination must align with federal requirements. Requires insurers to submit an annual report to DCBS demonstrating how the insurers’ provider networks meet requirements. Clarifies that the categories to be used in evaluating network adequacy are to use the factor-based approach, that the categories are to be established in statute and that the factors are to be established by rule. Establishes conditions under which DCBS is allowed to access insurers’ provider contracts. Establishes operative date on or after January 1, 2017. (Committee vote: 9-0-0)

**HB 2713-A**                      **ED**                      **dpa PE**                      **03/26/15**                      **Frederick**  
 Directs Secretary of State to conduct audit related to use of statewide standardized tests in public schools developed by multistate consortium. Provides that audit must address fiscal, administrative, and educational impacts of tests. Requires Secretary of State to report audit results to interim committees no later than September 15, 2016. Declares emergency, effective on passage. (Committee vote: 9-0-0)

**HB 2715-A**                      **ED**                      **dpa PE**                      **03/26/15**                      **Frederick**  
 Prohibits school district employee or volunteer from posting, publishing or making publicly available personally identifiable information in relation to results of performance-based assessment. Allows exception for posting of student-identifiable data if consent of student, or parent or guardian of student, is obtained. Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2015. (Committee vote: 9-0-0)

**HB 2892-A**                      **VET**                      **dpa PE**                      **03/26/15**                      **Esquivel**  
 Requires procurement and display of National League of Families’ POW/MIA flag on all state buildings and county courthouses with existing flagpoles, year-round. Requires all newly constructed public buildings be capable of properly displaying national, state and POW/MIA flags simultaneously. (Committee vote: 7-0-0)

 Increases the High Cost Disabilities (HCD) Grant from \$18 million per year to \$35 million. Applies first to the 2015-16 school year State School Fund distribution. Takes effect on July 1, 2015. (Committee vote: 6-0-3)

Kennemer**

Requires hospitals to adopt rules granting admitting privileges to Nurse Midwife Nurse Practitioners (NMNPs). Specifies that the adopted rules must include admitting privileges, be consistent with other medical staff privileges, permit NMNPs voting rights and address the governing of NMNPs credentialing. (Committee vote: 9-0-0)

**HB 2939-A**                      **ED**                      **dpa PE**                      **03/26/15**                      **Sprenger**

Prescribes salary calculation for substitute teachers in school district that has class schedule based on four-day week. Changes daily minimum salary multiplier to “1.125,” replacing “1.25.” Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2015. (Committee vote: 9-0-0)

**HB 3082**                      **HS**                      **dp**                      **03/30/15**                      **Piluso  
Frederick**

Provides alternate definition of “low income” for purposes of property tax abatement for non-profit corporation relating to housing. Directs governing bodies to designate use of standard or alternative definition of “low income.” Allows governing bodies to change currently adopted definition of “low income.” Takes effect 91st day after sine die. Sunsets June 30, 2027. (Committee vote: 6-0-3)
