<u>HB 2493-B</u>	REV		04/16/15	Barnhart

Modifies meeting schedule for State Debt Policy Advisory Commission to annually from every six months. Establishes the long-term forecast of the state's borrowing capacity targets to be at least for six years, and to make it consistent with the revenue forecast of the Oregon Department of Administrative Services. **Senate amendments: The amendment changes the time horizon from "long term" forecast to, "at least 6 years" and makes it consistent with the forecast of the Department of Administrative Services.** (Senate vote: Ayes: 23: Nays, 7--Girod, Knopp, Kruse, Olsen, Thatcher, Thomsen, Whitsett.)

Directs Higher Education Coordinating Commission (HECC) and State Board of Education (SBE) to oversee work group on community college placement to include consideration of use of statewide summative assessment. Requires preliminary report to Legislative Assembly no later than February 1, 2016 and final report no later than September 15, 2016. Declares emergency, effective on passage. (Committee vote: 9-0-0)

Exempts person operating registered farm vehicle from law prohibiting carrying dog on external part of vehicle. Applies to offenses occurring on or after effective date. (Committee vote: 9-0-0)

Requires subject employer to pay first installment of temporary disability compensation in workers' compensation claim within 14 days after employer has notice or knowledge of claim and of workers' disability if the medical provider authorizes the temporary disability compensation. (Committee vote: 9-0-2)

HB 3114-A **BL** **dpa PE** **04/14/15** **Kennemer**
 Allows injured worker to file workers' compensation claim within 90 days after health benefit plan rejects claim. Requires health benefit plan to pay benefits in accordance with terms, conditions and benefits of plan if workers' compensation claim is denied. (Committee vote: 9-0-2)

HB 3375-A **ED** **dpa PE** **04/14/15** **Frederick**
 Revises and renames Minority Teacher Act of 1991. Changes references to educator employment goals as relative to percentage of students in district. Requires Oregon Department of Education (ODE) to use federal reports on educator equity in certain monitoring activities. Mandates Higher Education Coordinating Commission (HECC) to require public teacher education programs to have plan to promote diverse educator output. Requires HECC and Oregon Education Investment Board (OEIB) to ensure implementation of plans. Removes school district-level plan requirements from measure, as introduced. Requires HECC and Education and Workforce Policy Advisor to report to Legislative Assembly each odd-numbered year. Replaces "technical assistance" with "guidance," where appropriate. (Committee vote: 7-0-2)

HB 3382 **AGNR** **dp** **04/14/15** **Esquivel**
 Defines Willamette Valley Protected District (District). Extends sunset prohibiting general growing of canola in District from January 2, 2019 to July 1, 2019. Directs College of Agricultural Sciences (College) at Oregon State University to use field monitoring and research of canola to identify acreages on which canola can be grown within District. Allows State Department of Agriculture (Department) to authorize up to 500 acres of commercial growing of canola within District on acreage identified by College and in manner College has determined to be compatible with growing other crops. Allows Department to assess civil penalty up to \$25,000 against person who grows canola without authorization. (Committee vote: 9-0-0)

HB 3487 **BL** **dp** **04/14/15** **Huffman**
 Requires licensed investigator to include name and license number in its advertisements. (Committee vote: 10-0-1)

HB 3495 **BL** **dp** **04/14/15** **Gomberg**
 Provides for employer and employee contributions to pension program and individual account program (IAP) of Oregon Public Service Retirement Plan to first be made for new members for wages attributed to services performed for the first full pay period following the six-month probationary period, without regard to when wages are considered earned for other purposes. (Committee vote: 9-0-2)

HB 3501 **BL** **dp** **04/14/15** **Hack**
Revises voting requirements for certain actions related to formation or conversion of benefit company.
(Committee vote: 10-0-1)

HOUSE BILLS:

HB 2034 **RCLUM** **dp** **04/15/15** **Olson**
Removes State Parks and Recreation Department's authority to exercise power of eminent domain over certain lands situated within boundaries of Willamette River Greenway. (Committee vote: 7-0-0)

HB 2261-A **TED** **dpa PE** **04/15/15** **Lively**
Permits person to provide proof of vehicle registration under certain circumstances in order to avoid the charge of illegal display of a vehicle registration plate or improper display of vehicle registration plate validating stickers. Directs the court to dismiss the charge if the person charged delivers proof of registration at the time the violation was committed. (Committee vote: 6-0-1)

HB 2281-A **TED** **dpa PE** **04/15/15** **McLain**
Makes issuance of fuel tax exemption emblems under the Road Usage Charge Program optional. Deletes requirement that mileage of vehicles participating in Road Usage Charge Program be rounded up to the next whole mile. (Committee vote: 6-0-1)

HB 2354-A **JUD** **dpa PE** **04/15/15** **Huffman**
Removes 400-foot zone for civil actions against operators of unmanned aircraft system flying over private property. Changes drone to "unmanned aircraft system" for consistency with federal language (Committee vote: Yeas: 8 - Barker, Barton, Greenlick, Krieger, Lininger, Olson, Sprenger, Williamson: Nays: 1 – Post)

HB 2465-A **TED** **dpa PE** **04/15/15** **Hack**
Authorizes Department of Transportation to establish, by rule, change of address requirements for driver licenses, driver permits and identification cards. Replaces requirement that applicants under 18 years of age provide proof of enrollment from school with the requirement that parent or guardian certify that applicant is enrolled in school, except in cases where the applicant's privileges have been suspended for withdrawal from school. Eliminates the moped-restricted driver license. Removes requirement that out-of-state applicants for a motorcycle endorsement take the motorcycle knowledge test in Oregon if the applicant already has such an endorsement in another state. (Committee vote: 7-0-0)

HB 2614-A **TED** **dpa PE** **04/15/15** **Kennemer**
 Allows ports and certain types of special districts to dispense fuel at nonretail dispensing facilities notwithstanding the requirement to purchase at least 900 gallons annually. Declares emergency, effective on passage. (Committee vote: 6-0-1)

HB 2625 **TED** **dp** **04/15/15** **Reardon**
 Creates the offense of unlawful parking in a space reserved for alternative fuel refueling. Designates offense as Class D traffic violation, punishable by maximum fine of \$100. (Committee vote: 6-0-1)

HB 2762-A **EE** **dpa PE** **04/15/15** **Nosse**
 Effective July 1, 2021, prohibits school district that provides breakfast or lunch at school site from using polystyrene foam plates, trays, food containers or food packaging. Allows school district to use polystyrene foam in meal service if district participates in recycling program for foam. Directs Department of Education to provide extension for school district able to show financial hardship experienced from complying with prohibition on use of polystyrene materials. Directs school district using polystyrene in meal service during 2014-2015 school year to establish plan to comply with measure. Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2015. (Committee vote: 8-0-1)

HB 2938 **RCLUM** **dp** **04/15/15** **Clem**
 Prohibits city from requiring consent to annexation of landowner's property in exchange for city providing county service as agent of county. Declares emergency, effective upon passage. (Committee vote: 7-0-0)

HB 2974-A **RULES** **dpa PE** **04/15/15** **Lininger**
 Requires Legislative Assembly or Secretary of State to hold public hearings throughout state prior to adopting congressional or legislative reapportionment plan. (Committee vote: 9-0-0)

HB 3255-A **TED** **dpa PE** **04/15/15** **Davis**
 Replaces requirement for rear reflector or light device when operating bicycle during limited visibility conditions with requirement for red light on rear of bicycle. (Committee vote: 6-0-1)

HB 3401-A **TED** **dpa PE** **04/15/15** **Nathanson**
 Directs Department of Transportation to study options for improving the on-time performance of passenger trains and to study options for optimizing ridership on passenger trains. Directs Department to develop passenger rail plan to increase ridership and ticket revenue. Requires Department to submit quarterly reports to interim legislative committees on transportation and a final report to the Legislative Assembly by November 30, 2015. Sunsets January 2, 2016. Declares emergency, effective on passage. (Committee vote: 6-0-1)

HB 3517-A **HC** **dpa PE** **04/15/15** **Gilliam
Greenlick**
 Authorizes Oregon Health Authority (OHA) to provide medical assistance on a discretionary basis, and within available funds, to children under 19 years of age whose family income is at or below 300 percent of federal poverty guidelines and who does not qualify for the Health Care for All Oregon Children program. Declares an emergency, effective on passage. (Committee vote: Yeas: 5 - Clem, Greenlick, Keny-Guyer, Lively, Nosse: Nays: 4 - Buehler, Hayden, Kennemer, Weidner)
